Amún Shéa is a private, non-profit educational center accredited by the Salvadoran Ministry of Education MINED for grades K-12 in Perquín, Morazán, El Salvador. We were founded in 2008 by Perkin Educational Opportunities Foundation, Inc., a 501(c)(3) registered in the U.S. and El Salvador.



Our students come from all across Morazán, the poorest region of El Salvador. Student tuition is largely subsidized, with families contributing on a sliding scale. Students receive healthy and balanced meals and learn in a safe, gender-inclusive environment.

We use Problem-based Learning methodology where our students learn by doing--whether in the traditional classroom, a scientific lab, or in our school greenhouse. Our students engage in hands-on investigations to create tangible change in their communities, tackling issues like unsafe drinking water, crop pests, and deforestation.
