

A LITTLE BIT ABOUT TEWA

Tewa is an organisation in Nepal comprising of 21 women members, a growing circle of friends and allies, and a gender-balanced team of advisors. Tewa aims to increase self-reliance of Nepalis and reduce their dependency on foreign donors by inculcating the habit to donate regularly for the sustainable and equitable development of the country, with special focus on women.

TEWA WILL WORK TOWARDS:

- reviving the culture of philanthropy and altruism, inherent in Nepali culture
- strengthening rural and urban communities that are breaking up due to media-led consumeristic lifestyles; migration; fragmentation of communities & families, and erosion of tradition & culture
- creating a social security net for the welfare of the needy—the women, the oppressed and the disadvantaged
- helping the highly motivated, but untapped Nepali women come into the mainstream of the country's development.

WHAT TEWA PLANS TO DO

Tewa members and volunteers will use indigenous methods—door to door campaigns, walk-a-thons, traditional *daan, puja*, festivals & specific fund-raising approaches outlined below for the establishment of a Tewa fund. Tewa will:

- seek lead donors who can give Rs. 10,000 annually,
- seek individual solicitation through Tewa volunteers, members and staff,
- reach out to Nepalis and friends of Nepal living abroad,
- conduct cause-related marketing through partnership with the corporate sector, and
- organize events & campaigns

Tewa will mobilise these funds to support development initiatives taken up by emerging

Tewa will identify and train a cadre of gender-balanced field-based development workers to help disseminate Tewa's philosophy, identify potential beneficiaries and also act as their facilitators, networkers and monitors.
