Timeline of our work

26 October 2010	exchanged contracts on Lot 46
29 October 2010	weed and invasive species removal began
2 November 2010	first 200 seedlings planted
30 November 2010	1,000th seedling planted
February 2011	cyclone Yasi struck and caused significant damage in zones 1-2. We lost 35 remnant trees.
April 2011	first cassowary juvenile spotted on Lot 46
June 2011	zone 1 completed. Over 3,000 trees planted
December 2011	cleared one hectare of bramble from zone 2
July 2012	planted 5,960th tree on zone 2
2013	bramble removed from zone 5 – the worst bramble in the area – up to 2m thick and 4m high in trees
2013-14	removed 180 tonnes of rubbish from zone 5
Dec 12 - July 2013	planted 15,000 trees in zones 3 & 4
Oct 13 – July 14	planted 16,000 trees in zones 5
April 2014	Cyclone Ita uprooted trees 5 trees in zone 3 (they are still growing whilst laying on their side and sending out suckers). Knocked over 100+ young trees we planted after 2012. We propped them up again and they are growing strongly
June 2014	first trees planted now 8+ metres tal
October 2014	cassowary first seen in 2010 now breeding and showing off his chicks
1 December 2014	37,000th tree planted (zone 6)
	Ground beneath trees planted in year one now 95% covered in leaf litter
