





Hospital San Vicente Fundación, located in Medelllín, Colombia. More than **60** years ago created the largest children's hospital in Antioquia, which has been a pioneer in the creation of interdisciplinary groups to address complex childhood pathologies such as: hemato-oncology, nephrology, burns, trauma surgery and congenital malformations, we serve the pediatric population between 0 and 15 years of age in the modalities of outpatient and inpatient.

We have a focus on high medical complexity led by pediatricians, specialists and pediatric subspecialists, we are leaders in pediatric renal transplantation at national and regional level.

We have a capacity of **195** hospital beds distributed in the following services: **18** of them belong to the oncology service.





ONCOLOGY SERVICE

Chemotherapy services are offered in comfortable spaces and pleasant environments for patients, in addition to constant communication with the medical team.

MENTAL HEALTH OF CANCER PATIENTS

It has been estimated that fatigue affects 96% of patients receiving chemotherapy treatment and 78-100% of those who have undergone radiotherapy.

One strategy within the framework of cancer treatment is physical exercise, which has been associated with an increase in life expectancy. The scientific evidence is solid and abundant about the positive effect of physical exercise on depression, anxiety and fatigue in cancer patients.

It is important to provide constant accompaniment to each cancer patient, especially to children, so that their process is calmer and does not generate sadness when they are no longer involved in their favorite daily activities.

To increase the survival rate of children with cancer, which we aim to achieve through three fundamental pillars: early diagnosis, advanced treatments supported by state-of-the-art technology and holistic support throughout the treatment process, promoting the recovery and emotional well-being of our patients.





We are dedicated to saving the lives of hundreds of children from all parts of the country each year through early diagnosis and timely treatment, led by experts and state-ofthe-art technology.

We focus on the human aspect, recognizing the unique emotional needs of cancer patients and promoting special projects to help them cope with their treatment process. **SOCIAL IMPACT**

Every month we perform **130** chemotherapies and there are **85** hospital discharges.

We have the capacity of **10** Chemotherapy cubicles and **18** Hospitalization beds.


WHY DONATE TO THE ONCOLOGY WARD OF SAN VICENTE HOSPITAL?
