MOST COMMON DISEASES OF OLDER ADULTS IN COLOMBIA

It has been identified that the leading causes of death after the age of 60 are cardiovascular diseases. cancer. chronic respiratory diseases and diabetes. Women have a higher prevalence of cerebrovascular, diseases and cervical and breast cancer. Men. on the other hand, have a higher prevalence of chronic diseases of the lower respiratory tract and colon, prostate and lung cancer. As for ischemic heart disease and diabetes, both have the same risk.

SOCIAL WORK

Social work is an area of our Hospital, which is responsible for providing support to our patients and companions in vulnerable situations, including indigenous communities, where there is economic and psychological support. Through cleaning kits, food, transportation, stay, talks, activities guided by other foundations or common people, among others, where these works are rooted in our mission to always provide a high quality service and constant welfare.

SOCIAL IMPACT

Every day we face the challenge of caring for a diverse population, mostly in vulnerable situations. Beyond providing quality medical care, we strive to preserve the human dignity of our patients during their illnesses, addressing aspects of hygiene, safety and emotional support. In this project we focus on the care of the elderly who are aged 50 and older and who have the possibility of accessing our oncology, transplant, physical medicine and rehabilitation services, and a neuroscience service (Alzheimer's and Parkinson's).
