Melaleuca Worldwide Compensation

You will earn Career and Value Pack commissions for all of your personal enrollees who purchase a career or value pack worldwide.

Worldwide Personally Enrolled Customer Commission

All of your personal enrollees worldwide will be used to determine whether you receive the 14% or 20% commissions on the purchases of personal enrollees.

Worldwide Leadership Pools Home Country Pools

Your Worldwide Status will determine your leadership pool participation, and all your leadership points generated worldwide (up to the 100 maximum) can be used in that leadership pool calculation. Your Net PC growth used in the pool calculation will be your home country organization PC growth only (that means that new PCs in a country other than your home country cannot be used to calculate Net PC Growth for your home country leadership pool.)
