WHERE WE WORK




The Province of Chaco is one of the most backward jurisdictions in the country.

- $^{igstyle \bullet}$ It is one of the provinces with the highest index of households with unsatisfied basic needs in rural areas: 31,4% $_1$
- It is the province with the highest percentage of children not enrolled in the initial level: 8.8% 2
- \bullet The illiteracy rate is the highest in the whole country: 5,5% $_{3}$

In the rural areas of Argentina,

- Every 4 students who finish primary school, only 1 will enroll in high school. 4
- In rural primary schools there is twice as much repetition and abandonment as in urban ones. 5

OUR PROGRAMS



SCHOOLING

The Schooling Program aims to improve the learning, promotion and permanence of the children through the transformation of the school together with the educational community. To achieve this, it makes human, didactic and infrastructure resources available to schools.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The program seeks to promote education for young people from rural areas, accompanying them to continue their studies in the nearest town through follow-up with personalized tutoring, the total financing of their studies and the involvement of their families as key players in their education.

685 CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE PARTICIPATED IN OUR PROGRAMS AND 258 YOUNG PEOPLE ACCESSED THE SECONDARY SCHOOL



SCHOOLING PROGRAM



During 2019 we will implement the Schooling Program in 20 rural schools with more than 400 direct beneficiaries.

The program includes the following three lines of work:

School support through the DALE Proposal!*

The program is developed as a tool to teach children to read and write in contexts of poverty that are not progressing at the pace of their peers. It is a systematic proposal, which provides for the attention of children twice a week, individually. For this implementation, we have a trained team that visits the schools weekly.

Development and distribution of pedagogical booklets.

The booklets provide specific didactic material for students of rural schools and are developed by our team of professionals in Educational Sciences, together with the teachers and directors of the schools where Voy con Vos works. The booklets allow students to continue reinforcing concepts learned in school, in their homes, and thus involve parents in their education.

Proposal of Learning Communities**.

Process of transformation of the school and its environment through the implementation of "Educational Success Actions" that increase academic performance and improve coexistence and attitudes of solidarity, favoring the participation of the community, with the objective to overcome social inequalities. This process involves all those who, influence the learning and development of students; among them teachers, relatives, people from the neighborhood, members of associations and neighborhood organizations.

SCHOLARSHIPS PROGRAM



Guarantee access to secondary school for 78 students:

- Total financing of lodging and food expenses.
- Total financing of supplies, study materials and uniform.
- Team of rented tutors to carry out personalized follow-up to each scholarship holder: individual weekly and group meetings, intervention in case of school drop-out risk and immediate elevation and report of critical cases.
- Carrying out workshops on "Family Involvement" for family members of the scholars. Workshops are delivered by Operators in Social Psychology, part of the team at Voy con Vos.
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- Carrying out workshops on "Emotional education and group strengthening" for our scholars. Workshops are delivered by Operators in Social Psychology, part of the team at Voy con Vos.






VOY CON VOS IN NUMBERS
