Dear Global Giving,

Thank you for the opportunity to be considered for fundraising in the Global Giving Accelerator Program.

In July 1st 2016, Save & Nurture Child Care Foundation was founded and was active for 2 years before registering the organization in March 25th, 2019 which was established as a 501 (c) 3 not-for-profit organization with the purpose of focusing on the welfare of the abuse children, less privileged children and children with special needs. Also providing a safe haven where youth participate in a comprehensive program of change making in developing countries, also positively impacts children, especially abused children.

Our program, the SNCC ambassador of change program discovers, connects, mentor, motivate, empower and engage young people, especially girls and young women to actively commit to change making and create change in their countries. This program promotes the physical, educational and life skills necessary to prepare and empower young people for leadership in their communities and success in their personal lives.

In the three short years of active engagement and service to humanity, since its founding, the Save & Nurture Child Care Foundation has played a major role in the transformation in the lives of children and young people from a country with too many unproductive, unsupervised kids with too much time to get into trouble to one providing these youth with a valuable structured program. The introduction and proper management of the SNCC ambassador of change program uses advocacy and sensitization of youths and the public to discover youths with leadership skills and build young change makers with our youth empowerment curriculum to “empower and engage young people by providing the necessary training, mentoring, guidance, tools and finances and a life skills program that promotes positive values, healthy habits, and education through the change making and outreach activities – resulting in real life transformation, on and off the program.”



A priority need for the SNCC ambassador of change program, which operates and engages change makers in developing countries, is funding for the supplies of basic amenities such as the building of public schools, purchasing of school kits, such as school bags, shoes, school uniforms, water and water bottles, food and food flasks and part-time program staff.

In the past, we have relied on volunteer or minimally compensated staff. This has resulted in high turnover, continued difficulty attracting qualified personnel, and limited continuity for the participants whose success depends on positive role models and the relationships they build with children and their mentees.

The Save & Nurture Child Care Foundation is requesting \$ 5,000 from the donors on Global Giving to support our project in Buea, Cameroon. The programs makes a meaningful difference in the lives of youths in developing countries, thereby also positively impacting the less privileged children, abused children, children with special needs and other children facing child- related challenges.

A contribution from Global Giving will give us the jumpstart we need to execute our project in Buea, Cameroon while we continue to implement our recently developed fundraising plan. We believe that the SNCC ambassador of change program is consistent with the mission and interest of discovering young talented people, especially young women, engage them in change making activities and building change makers in developing countries to work with others, NGOs and ambassadors to overcome the obstacles that abuse, poverty, hunger, malnutrition, violence, wars, diseases, developmental disabilities and discrimination place in a girl- child's path by focusing on different programs and activities that support and nurture the less privileged children in Africa and other part of the world. We hope that you will find it in your hearts and budget to support this program in Buea, Cameroon.

## REQUEST FOR FUNDS

### POPULATION SERVED

(300 demographics)

200 Youth 14- 16 years old and 100 children ages 6- 12; 70% come from single parent families and/or live with a grandparent or other caregiver. Virtually all participants qualify for the SNCC Girl Empowerment, SNCC Kids Entrepreneurship and free lunch during the program, and are considered low-income.

Population: 90% female, 10% male;

### OUTCOMES AND EVALUATION

At least 95% of participants will complete program as measured by attendance records. At least 92% of participants will demonstrate academic improvement as measured by quarterly report cards, teacher progress reports and tutor feedback.

### PARTNERS

The SNCC ambassadors of change team Buea, Cameroon strongly believes that the formula for providing effective, cost-efficient and high quality programs includes collaboration with many community organizations.

Save & Nurture Child Care Foundation in collaboration with SNCC ambassadors of change, team Buea- Cameroon, partners with the following groups to create efficient and effective service to humanity in Buea, Cameroon:

20 SNCC Ambassadors of Change, Cameroon – identifies children for the programs

1 State Library – provides computer lab for homework assistance

10 Church parishioners - serve as volunteer tutors and mentors

20 SNCC Ambassadors and 10 University/college students – serve as volunteer tutors and mentors

5 Paid teaching staff- serves as back- up/ supporting teacher and guidance counselor consultant

2 School – provides space for tutoring



SNCC Foundation - serve as a resource for continuing education and development of volunteer board members

The secondary general education curriculum in Cameroon – provides curriculum for life skills"

## **SUSTAINABILITY OF PROJECT**

To serve eligible youth and children who are victims of the crises in Cameroon and virtually all of whom are unable to pay for their education or are unable to attend school because of the crises in Cameroon, Save & Nurture Child Care Foundation has developed a fundraising plan which includes initiating an annual fund drive targeted to individuals; an annual banquet/auction; funding requests to area civic clubs and organizations; corporate and foundation grants.

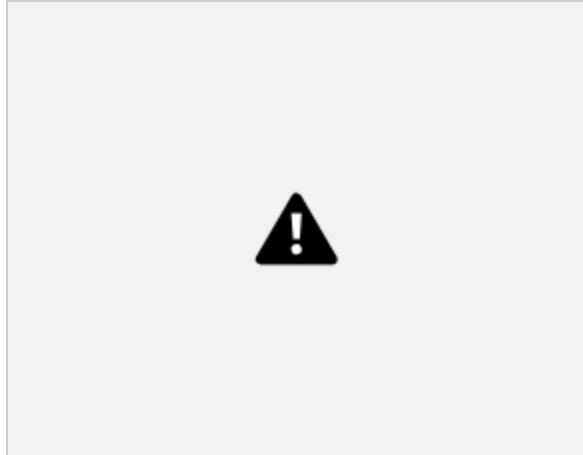
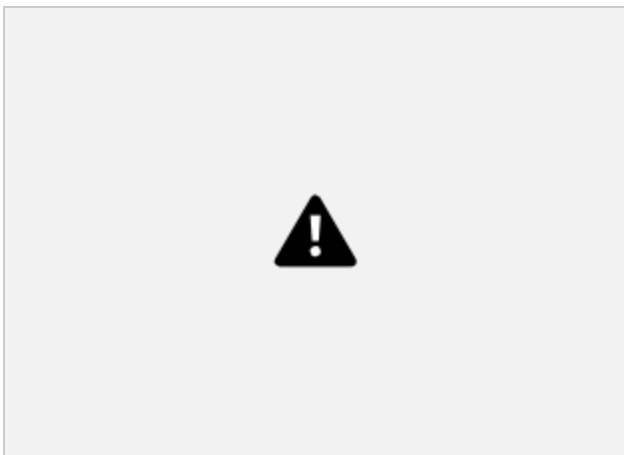
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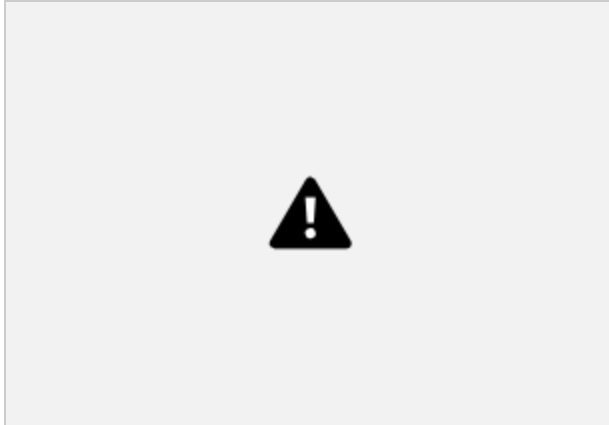
