We are a local non-profit making organization founded in 1996.

The organization promotes sexual and reproductive health rights for women and children and undertakes activities also in Gender equality, women and children basic rights, women economic rights, women empowerment health and educational infrastructure projects, and provision of water and sanitation in the Republic of Ghana.

MAMACARE-GHANA ORGANIZATION is registered with the registrar General's Department of the Republic of Ghana and obtained a certificate of incorporation of a Company under the Companies Act 1963, Act 179 as a Limited by Guarantee.

MAMACARE-GHANA ORGANIZATION is also registered with the department of social welfare and obtained a certificate of recognition as a national non-governmental organization.

OUR VISION

MamaCare-Ghana Organization (MMCGO) envision a society in which all women and girls can exercise their fundamental human rights to: Access by all pregnant women to prenatal care, trained attendants during child birth and referral facilities for high risk pregnancies and obstetric emergencies Access by all couples to information and services to prevent pregnancies which are too early, too closely spaced, too late or too many Access the information, resources, and services they need to enhance and protect their health and achieve their full potential.

Make informed decisions about their sexuality, relationships, pregnancy, child-bearing, and marriage and all other matters related to their sexual and reproductive health and rights, free of discrimination, coercion, and violence; and participate in and assume leadership to advance sexual and reproductive health and rights.

OUR MISSION

Training of traditional birth attendants, community health workers, community health nurses on basic midwifery practices.

Provide health infrastructure thus construction of CHPs compounds, maternity homes and school infrastructure.

Provision of water and sanitation through mechanized boreholes, improved pit latrines (KVIP) and rain water harvest.



OUR ACHIEVEMENT AND IMPACT

Since its creation, MamaCare-Ghana organization has undertaken a number of training workshops for practicing but untrained community midwives. So far, the organization has trained 200 practicing but

untrained community midwives from about 100 villages in Hohoe municipality, Afadzato South District and outh Dayi District.

MamaCare-Ghana provided a training programme for 80 women in income generation, basic financial management.

Through MamaCare-Ghana programs, over 50,000 people have become more knowledgeable on family Planning, HIV/ AIDS and other Sexual Transmitted Infections (STIs). MamaCare-Ghana organization had organized five workshops for people living with HIV/ AIDS in the Hohoe Municipality.

Mamacare-ghana has trained about 70 community health nurses in emergency delivery. We have provided mother and child delivery kits, medical supplies and equipments and medicines to the health centers both public and private clinics in the Volta Region and Greater Accra Region of Ghana.

WHAT WE DO

We promote maternal and child health rights for women and children.

Training and Equipping traditional birth attendants, Community Health Workers and Community Health Nurses to provide maternal & child care; to hard to reach areas of the project regions.

Distributing Insecticide Mosquito Bed Nets to Pregnant women and Children Under five.



Training of Community Volunteers; to educate community people on Food and Nutrition, exclusive breast feeding and basic nutrition for Mother and Child.

Training of Paralegal to educate and advocate for fundamental human rights in the communities while promoting gender equality and women in community decision and leadership positions.

We Construct and refurbishes health centers, maternity homes, CHPs Compounds and School infrastructure mainly for basic education.b

We source funding to support communities with and Sanitation through Mechanized Boreholes and Improved Pit latrines for Basic Schools.

MamaCare-Ghana also empowers women through basic skill training and access to Savings and loans teaching women how to keep basic bookkeeping.

We collaborate with Ministry of Agriculture to give basic technological training for women peasant farmers in their communities.

Collaborate with Ghana Health Services (GHS), Midwifery Training School, Hospitals, Health Centers,health facilities and Clinics.

Collaborate with Municipal Assemblies and District Assemblies.

Collaborate with Ministry of Education.

Collaborate with Department of Social welfare and protection.
