China Cal Burma Refugee Children Project.

Business Plan Summary.

China Cal plans to screen 10,000 Burmese refugee children for heart disease during 2020.

Screening will start in July, 2020 with cooperation from the Burma Children's Medical Fund, Mae Tao Clinic and Help Without Frontiers, all of Mae Sot, Thailand.

Funding for screening will be supported from this project and from Help Without Frontiers. We estimate about \$8000 will be needed to fund transportation, supplies, meals for screening personnel. China Cal will contribute half of this amount. Help Without Frontiers will contribute half.

Funding for treatments will be shared between China Cal, Burma Children's Medical Fund and Mae Tao Clinic. It is expected that up to 30 children with heart disease requiring surgery will be found. China Cal will contribute \$16,000 toward surgical treatments for children found with heart disease. Burma Children's Foundation will contribute the remainder of surgical support. Mae Tao clinic will provide medical treatment to all children needing it free of charge or at nominal fees (\$2 per visit)
