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Organizational Background

Beellahy Foundation is a Non-Governmental Organization founded and incorporated on the 8th of May 2019 with registration number RC: 128849. As the name implies 'with God Foundation' we believe that all things are possible. According to the inspiring words of the former president of the United States of America, Barack Obama:

"The best way to not feel hopeless is to get up and do something. Don't wait for good things to happen to you. If you go out and make some good things happen, you will fill the world with hope, you will fill yourself with hope".

The BEELLAHY FOUNDATION (BF) project is borne out of undying passion of the founder. BF, is a care giving, life sustaining project ideologically created to rewrite the unsavoury narratives of the less privileged in our society. It is a social institution conceptualized with a clear intention to place a higher premium on the value of human dignity, life and existence. In the world we find ourselves today, the yawning gap between the privileged and less or underprivileged is indescribably identifiable, not to mention the emotional depression the people we identify as the less privileged face. In a bid to relieve these inner yearnings, part of our goals as an organization is to accomplish the following:

- To train the less privileged in the society
- To empower them and
- Provide them with required training tools.

We hope to further our progress of reaching the less privileged locally and internationally through the project outlined in this proposal.

Problem Statement

The 'Nigeria vision 2020' of 2008 states that, **"By 2020 Nigeria will be one of the 20 largest economies in the world, that would be able to consolidate its leadership role in Africa and establish itself as a significant player in the global economic and political arena."** Now, we are in the year 2019; but the vision looks woefully unrealistic, with no glimpse of hope for the young Nigerian. The economy is sprawling too low, while the people scamper for ways to survive. The school-aged Nigerian children have more resorted to hawking in traffic, while some ride keke-napep (tricycle) for survival. The question is: How do we make life more meaningful and worth living in Nigeria and beyond? How much does it bother you when a neighbour of yours merely exists in abject penury, barely grappling with a single, malnourished meal in a day? These are few cases. Nigerians are also being enslaved in other countries due to the poor economic situation bedeviling their country. The South Africans gleefully brutalize Nigerians by the day because they (the Nigerians) went in search of greener pastures there. Precious souls are daily starving to death. How are we going to arrest this carnage?

However, Beellahy Foundation is giving hope to the hopeless, and that, by the special grace of God; just as everything is turning very possible.

Project Justification

In response to these problems, Beellahy Foundation has come with the initiative to educate the under-aged the true value of education and soliciting supports from a well-meaning Nigerian to support this project in order to support these people (the less privileged youth/children with different skill acquisitions, empower them, also to support them with the tools required for self-reliance.

Project Goals

Completion of this project will further our overarching objectives, including:

1) Goal & Objectives

- a. Educating the younger ones on the true value of being educated.
- b. Reducing poverty and enhancing livelihood options for the less privileged
- c. Increase income for youths through agriculture development with online trading platforms
- d. Enhancement of skills and capacities of youths in alternative livelihoods
- e. Women empowerment

2) Project Results

- a) Establishment of scholarships for school children and a well conducive learning environment with learning tools
- b) Less privileged will be motivated by providing food stuffs, given little grants to take care of their upkeep.
- c) Agricultural productivity will be made profitable and interesting (for youths) by using new technology & enhancing marketing skills also to increase savings & take credit through microfinance to afford education for the youths
- d) Alternative livelihood opportunities for youths will be developed like establishing computer centers so as to have access to modern technology tools and explore themselves.
- e) Microenterprise Development Strategy will be established for Women

3) Alternative Livelihoods for Youths

- Providing educational scholarships for high-merit youths to undertake further education
- Training and capacity building of youths in adopting new and alternative livelihood opportunities
- Establishment of computer centers for youths to increase their intellectual capability.

4) Microenterprise Development Strategy for Women

- Identifying new and potential microenterprises for women
- Supporting women with seed capital in launching microenterprises
- Establishing marketing linkages and value chains for women undertaking microenterprises
- Provision of tools after training

5) Monitoring & Evaluation

- There will be constant check on the activities which will help review the progress made at every step.
- There will be external mechanism (Auditor) to monitor the results, risks, assumptions and performance regularly through meetings and submission of reports.
