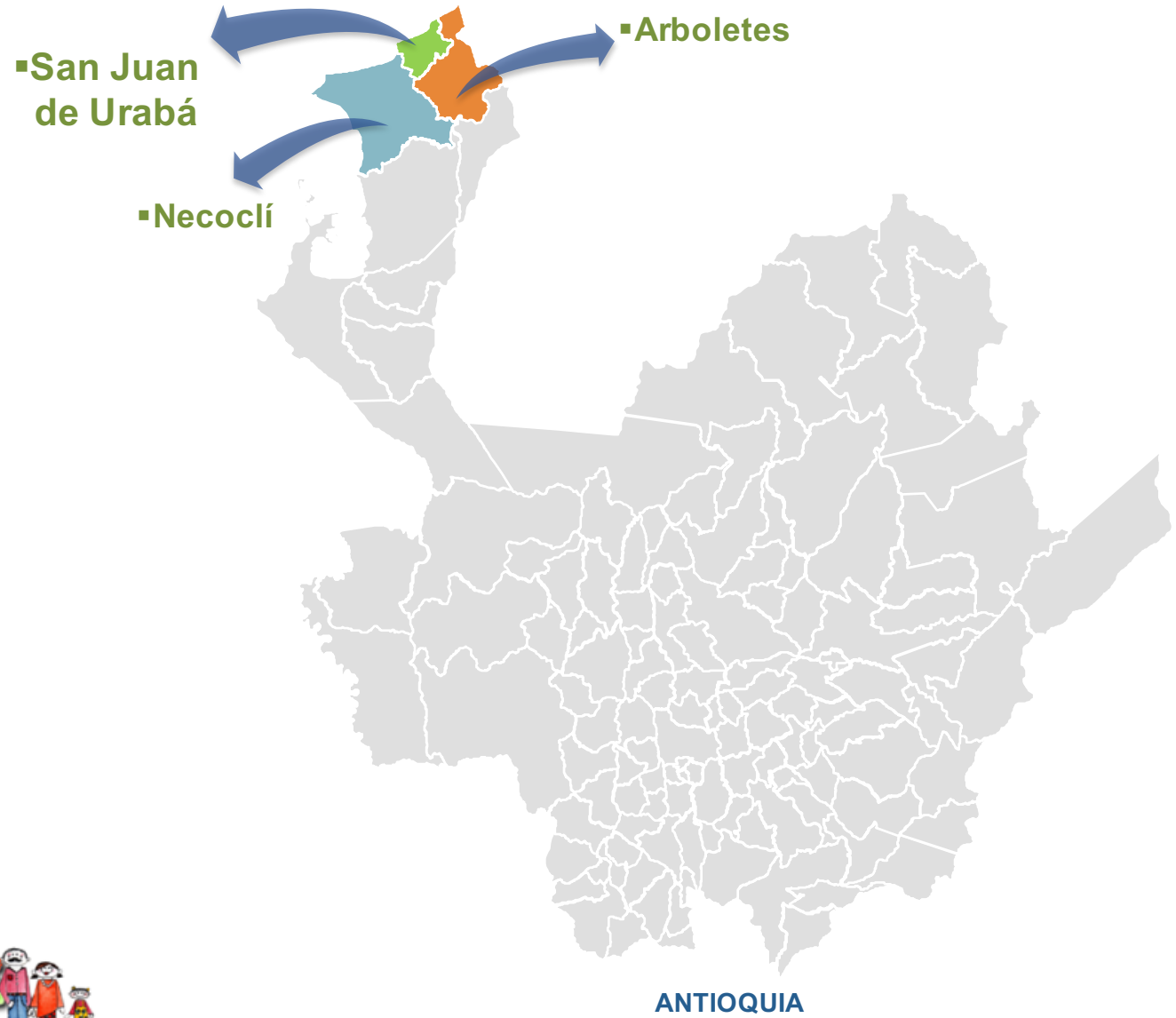

To improve the living conditions of families in extreme poverty in Urabá region through a comprehensive strategy that combines the reconstruction of their homes and the development of a family strengthening program



To ensure sustainable habitat through the reconstruction of housing, the improvement of the environment and the establishment of ties of bonding, coexistence and social fabric



To develop and strengthen families through processes of integral and permanent formation that generate social capital and empowerment in the most vulnerable communities of Urabá



To contribute to the generation of income through the implementation or strengthening of family businesses, or agricultural and poultry; which also contribute to the home and nutritional benefit

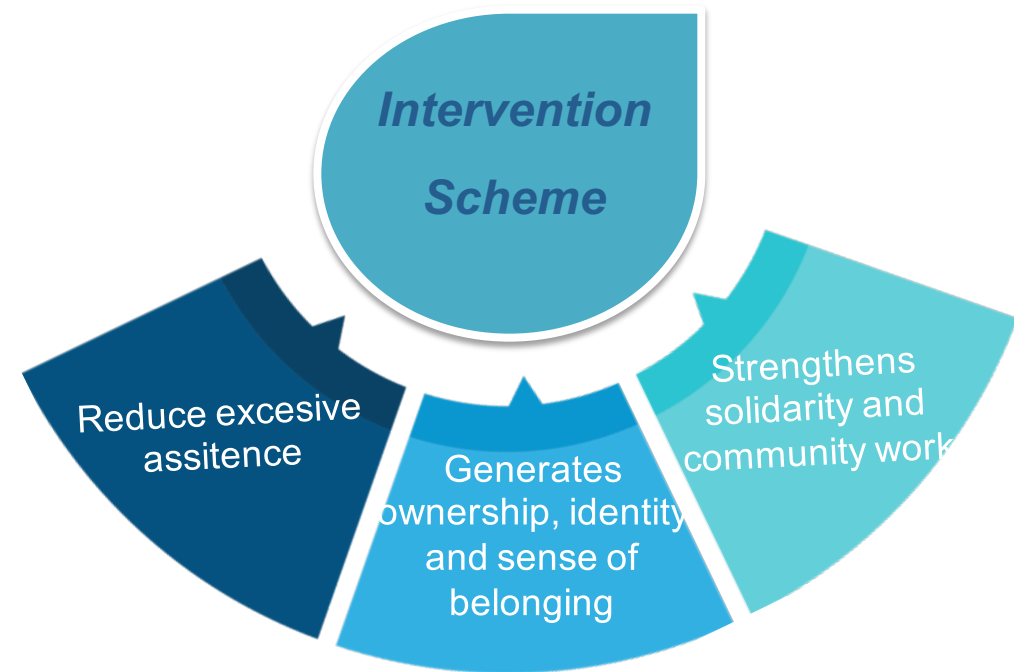

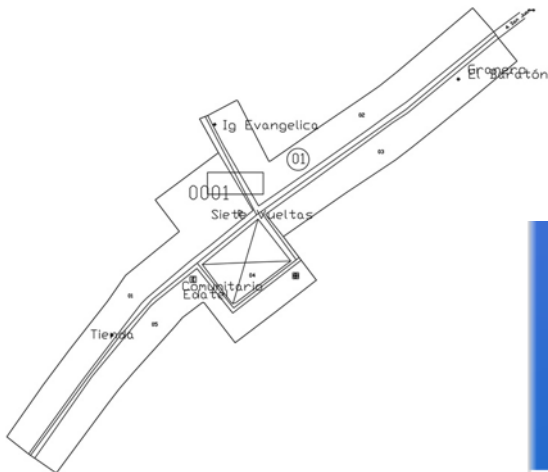


SUSTAINABLE HOUSING

Each family receives inputs for a productive project. Ten hens at laying age with the necessary implements for the construction of the chicken coop, food for the first months and training for its management. Families that have their own initiatives receive inputs according to their project.



Siete Vueltas Village



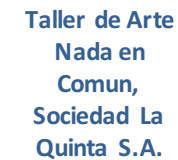
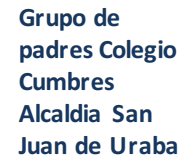
.....> Siete Vueltas Village located 20 kilometers from the town center of the municipality of San Juan de Urabá, with a population of 1030 inhabitants; which live in 125 homes, only 15 had a bathroom.

.....> The intervention in Siete Vueltas began in 2016 with the objective of rebuilding the 125 homes and contributing to the empowerment of families that have been victim of the armed conflict and living in extreme poverty.

.....> Thanks to the support of different allies, 82 homes have already been rebuilt, generating a housing solution for families. The challenge is to ensure that all families have decent and safe housing
