Methodology envisaged

Project description:

project consists in supporting the DOURBE public primary school in commune of N'Dali to set up for the 2020-2021 school year, а school composed of a building of approximately 100 m2 with 2 closed premises, a kitchen and an open, courtyard-like room serving as a dining hall. The canteen will be supported by the establishment of a school nursery garden for the diversification of pupils' meals / meals of the production through vegetables, bananas from the nursery garden and education in the protection of the environment.

The aim of the project is to improve the food and learning conditions of pupils in general and of the poorest pupils (whose parents are poor) in particular while teaching them about environmental protection measures.

It will mainly involve the construction of a canteen, and the establishment of a garden-nursery within the school which will have water drilling. The school nursery garden is a fenced space within the school and divided into two plots, the first of which

will serve as a school garden for the production of vegetables by the students themselves for their consumption through the school canteen and the second plot will serve as a school nursery for the production of tree seedlings by the students themselves for planting through the "one pupil-one tree" strategy.

The surplus of vegetables which will be produced by the pupils will be sold to the parents of pupils to benefit the whole family in general and the children of the family in particular, also the seedlings will be produced for the needs of the school but especially for the parents' associations (APE) and for the rest of the population for tree planting.

Contrary to the approach often taken by the government feeding program, which entrusts the management of canteens to the Directors of schools who have neither budget nor technical assistance, ITODJU NGO will work in close collaboration with the office of the parents association of DOURBE students.

In fact, the revenue from the sale of vegetables or tree seedlings will be managed by the parents' association and will be used to buy ingredients (oils, salts, dishes, spoons, soap, etc.) to strengthen the canteens. school, to pay the incentive bonuses for women responsible for preparing canteen meals, for the sustainability of the project, for

the purchase of supplies for the poorest of the students, for the establishment of a small pharmacy within schools for the benefit of children and the funding of social projects in these schools.

The garden will be a place of theoretical and practical learning for children in environment, vegetable and agricultural production. The aim of the project is to improve the food and learning conditions of pupils in general and of the poorest pupils (whose parents are poor) in particular while teaching them about environmental protection measures.

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Project justification:

In Benin and in particular in the rural commune of N'Dali, the majority of school children come from poor families who are unable to provide adequate food. It is very

common to meet children who barely eat once every 12 hours. These underprivileged and hungry children are unable to follow the lessons of the teachers well, since some of them come from remote villages which have no school and they spend the afternoon at school. We are then witnessing high rates of school drop-out by these children or poor academic performance. Aware of this situation, the government has undertaken actions to endow schools with canteens, which unfortunately only covers a crippled part of the town of N'Dali and even face severe ordeals such the embezzlement of food, the increase in number of children enrolled in the canteen. This project consists of supporting the DOURBE public primary school to set up for the 2019-2020 back-to-school period, a school canteen supported by a school garden for full-time access to food and diversification meals / meals through the of pupils' production of vegetables, cereals. Ultimately, it will allow at least 200 schoolchildren not only to have a balanced and varied plate but also to keep them in school.

Beneficiary populations (characteristics and number)

The direct beneficiaries of the project:

The direct beneficiaries of the project are 200 children aged 6 to 14 from the public primary school in the village of DOURBE.

Among other things, the project will provide the following benefits:

- A diversified and varied diet for good growth of children at school and at home through the

establishment of a school canteen, a school nursery garden

- The creation of favorable learning conditions for poor children through the establishment of the school canteen;
- Reinforcement of children's capacities in agricultural production, seedling production, planting and maintenance of trees and in the environment in general;
- The strengthening of the financial autonomy of the school allowing it to meet the small needs of school children such as the purchase of school supplies for disadvantaged children.
- Improvement of hand hygiene conditions in the DOURBE public primary school
- Reducing the harmful effects of climate change on the area and creating a favorable microclimate for children.

The beneficiaries in general at DOURBE: The indirect beneficiaries of the project are here parents' association (APE), the teachers of the beneficiary school and the populations of the village of DOURBE, the beneficiary school of the project. Among other things, the project will provide them with the following benefits:

- Improving the diet of their children at school and at home;
- The reduction in their expenses in terms of providing meals for children during school hours, for midday breakfasts, for APE contributions, for meeting small school needs etc.:
- Reinforcement of their capacities in terms of seedling production, planting and maintenance of trees, environmental education;
- Land security through the planting of trees on their plots (men and women);
- Reduction of the harmful effects of climate change on the area and creating a favorable microclimate for humans, animals and the biodiversity.

Expected results (short, medium and long term)

The expected results through the implementation of our project are as follows:

- 1 school canteen is set up within the DOURBE public primary school in the commune of N'Dali;
- -200 pupils from 6 0 to 14 years old from the DOURBE public primary school have a hot meal a day;
- -1 attractive school garden is set up in DOURBE;
- -60 students are trained in ecologically sustainable vegetable production techniques
- 5 hand washing stations are installed;
- -Water drilling was carried out with a simplified irrigation system for the garden
- -The populations of the beneficiary village and those of the surrounding villages are aware of the need to keep children in school.
- The pupils of the DOURBE school are introduced to the protection of the environment.

HUMAN RESSOURCES

Human resources mobilized for the project (example: number of employees, their functions and number of working hours):

The project for the construction of a school canteen and education for environmental protection at the public primary school in DOURBE is a long-term project.

ITODJU intends to recruit two salaried agents; but the project will be managed by the facilitation of the team already in place, composed as follows:

A project manager who monitors and coordinates all activities; it is he who will report on the development of activities; as part of this project, he will produce activity reports and financial reports to the Executive

Management and to all the technical or financial partners involved in its implementation.

The two field animators will prioritize the execution and mobilization of awareness sessions in the villages; for this purpose, they will be in permanent contact with the actors and auxiliaries of the project (village chiefs, village delegate, members of the office of the parents' association, the Director of the school and the beneficiaries) on field.

The secretary of the Executive Direction will take care of administrative matters (relations with partners), logistics and financial matters alongside the Program Officer.

The Executive Director of ITODJU ONG will supervise the various activities.

The consultant will be responsible for initiating and training learners in market gardening techniques.
