BACKGROUND

- Save a Victim foundation is a non-governmental organization situated at Bortianor, Greater Accra Region Ghana. The overriding purpose of the organization is the transformation of the lives of victims in the society We are dedicated to meeting the fundamental needs of the disadvantaged minorities, impoverished and remote communities in Ghana and through our five units which cater for Domestic victims, Early and Force Marriages, Legal Aids, Water and Sanitation and Emergency Relief/Skill Acquisition.

GOAL

- The goal of the Project is to ensure that people with limited livelihood choices gain the resources to be financially secured. Our livelihood development programs use an integrated approach to holistically prepare families to be resilient to unforeseen shocks and able to provide for the needs of their families today and tomorrow.

PROBLEMS THAT THE FOUNDATION IS TRYING TO SOLVE

- The foundation has realized that most men abuse their wives or fiancées when they are solely responsible for the upkeep of the family. Helping these women to acquire workable skills and also contribute to the upkeep of the house can reduce such violence at home. Also, providing unemployed females with entrepreneurial skills can empower them to make their own decisions and reduce sexual abuse against women.
- We provide them with skills training so that they can cater for their families or assist their husbands to take care of their families. We also train unemployed females or graduates. The foundation provides them with the necessary resources or funding to set up their businesses. The trainees in turn also employ people in the society in their various firms.

TYPES OF TRAINING

- The Foundation provides the following training
- 1. Cake soap making
- 2. Liquid soap making
- 3. Handwashing soaps
- 4. Detergents
- 5. Floral decoration
- 6. Cake making
- 7. Beads making
- 8. Hair Shampoo
- 9. Hair Conditioner
- 10. Sewing
- 12. Hair dressing

BENEFICIARIES

- The project is targeted to females in the society, including victims and the unemployed in the society.

SUSTAINABILITY

- The foundation provides them with the necessary resources so that they start on their own. The resources are refunded with an interest of 4% which is paid every week to the foundation. The interest paid would be used to sustain the project, administration and other social activities
- The project will provide the continuous fundraising for the project so as to attract other external funds. Also we will continuously submit proposals to donors as a resourcing strategy to secure funds beyond the project funding cycle.

EXPECTED OUTCOME

- The training will help prevent domestic violence at home.
- The training would provide them with entrepreneurial skills which will benefit them throughout their lives
- The training will increase their income
- They will be able to cater for the welfare of their family
- They will also employ other women in their various businesses.
