## URGENT NEED: FENCE

Currently, our biggest issue is a lack of a fence. There have been a lot of issues from trespassing, to theft, to cows charging & crushing crop, and we are at the point where it not only costs us to not have a fence, but it is also a safety issue.

The fence is expensive (\$10k total, \$8k to go), so we are working it in stages and doing what we can when we can. Fence poles have been made on school property to help reduce transportation costs. Next is to dig the ground and plant the poles around the property. Then we will purchase the chain link and fence in the property in stages.

Once the property is fenced in the children, crops, and building will be safer from theft, intruders, and outside animals. Donations towards the fence construction can be made on the website or via GlobalGiving - thank you so much!

## PAINTED CLASSROOMS!

As you may have noticed, MCEC has been partially painted! This is a huge deal and the children are so excited by it. In many areas of Africa (including where MCEC is located) paint is very expensive and seen as a luxury. However, paint also has a huge effect on mood and can help to keep the children inspired throughout the long days. So far we have been able to paint seven classrooms, one latrine and the dining hall.
