Background

Brave To Love is a registered non-profit organization that rescues, restore and rehabilitate women and children that were trafficked in South-Africa and neighboring countries. These ladies come out of poor communities and are luered by traffickers by fake job oppertunities or many times a fun night out with friends and waking up in the nightmare of being forced to take drugs and sell their bodies for sex on our streets.

A Second Phase Restoration Home Need

Brave To Love has been working with many wonderful Trafficking In Person (TIP) Safehouses and Drug Rehabs but there is a huge need for second phase houses in South-Africa which are currently non-existent. We have explored a second phase house in the USA and have seen how this a great opportunity in South-Africa. The challenge currently is that the ladies have a limited time they can stay in a safe-house after being rescued and most of the time the family relationships are non-existant or extremely broken, many ladies growing up as orphans.

Restoration and Reintegration Opportunity

The second phase restoration home will give the ladies a limited period of developing skill while living in the home. Depending on the level of education the girl has, a development program will be followed according to her need. There will be a reintegration into a work environment and then back into society.

Immediate Need

- 1. Putting in Electricity Meter (Est. R4000)
- 2. Renovation of Property (Est. R250 000)
- 3. Raising Funds to Support a Social Worker, Nurse and House Parents (Est. R40 000 pm)
- 4. LED Lights (R4500)
- 5. Security of Property (R60 000)
- 6. Paint (R10 000)
- 7. Farming (R500 per lime tree needed)
- 8. Solar System (Est. R200 000)
- 9. Lawn Mower (R3000)
- 10. Outside doors and locks (R5000)
- 11. Refurbishment of Tractor (R3000)

Monthly Running Cost

- 1. Raising Funds to Support a Social Worker, Nurse and House Parents (Est. R40 000 pm)
- 2. Monthly Electricity (R5000-R10000) Depending if solar is installed. There is a borehole but depending on farming needs and how many people live on the property.
- 3. Monthly cost per lady (Est.R2000) (Medical need, transport, groceries)

4. Groceries for House (Est.R5000)

Future Need

- 1. Minibus (R300 000)
- 2. New bunk beds and bedding (x4 sleeps 8) (Est. R16 000)
- 3. Drywall partitioning inside

The property has a great opportunity to generate income through farming and there is a great opportunity for people wanting to get involved with this.
