## In Kisumu West sub-county, there are approximately **8,600 elders** that need the support of our trained caregivers.

Our **Daycare Program** is designed to allow seniors to socialize with their neighbors and stimulates their cognitive and mental awareness. This program provides our trained caregivers with the opportunity to evaluate the needs of rural seniors and educate them about various health concerns. Research has consistently shown a dramatic improvement in an elder's quality of life when they are provided with the opportunity to social and connect with their neighbors. and our program is designed to do that!

Our **Homecare Programs** allow our trained caregivers to evaluate and provide basic care services to homebound, rural seniors. Elders enrolled in this program are unable to attend daycare programs and visits by our caregivers maybe the only social interaction they experience.

Our **Residential Facility** provides room and board as well as around the clock services to seniors that are unable to care for themselves. This modern facility will be the first of its kind in rural Kenya and will provide seniors with a safe place to recover after hospitalization and when they can no longer care for themselves in the village.

We received an international donation of medical supplies including wheelchairs and hospital beds.




#### October 2017

Our first business plan was developed and rated highly by investors as a social enterprise.


#### **March 2018**
