

# AFTER SCHOOL CARE PROGRAMME

## **Background**

- The children leave school every afternoon and have nowhere to go, since they do not have access to affordable, after-school opportunities.
- After school hours are the peak time for juvenile crimes and risky behaviours, including alcohol, drug abuse and child trafficking.
- Children who do not spend any time in after-school activities are exposed to drugs, alcohol abuse and teenage pregnancy.

# Aim of the programme

- To nurture young children and adolescences who are otherwise unsupervised due to their parents working and unable to afford quality care.
- To assist the children with their school work to better their grades.

#### **TARGET**

We aim to reach 20 Orphan and Vulnerable Children per annum

• We aim to get OCV's that are Boys and Girls between 7 and 18 years

## Durations of the session

• The OVC's will attend 3 days a week Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday

### **ACTIVITIES**

- Home Work Sessions
- Reading lessons
- Computer literacy classes
- Search for talent (dancing, singing, acting, art and craft)
