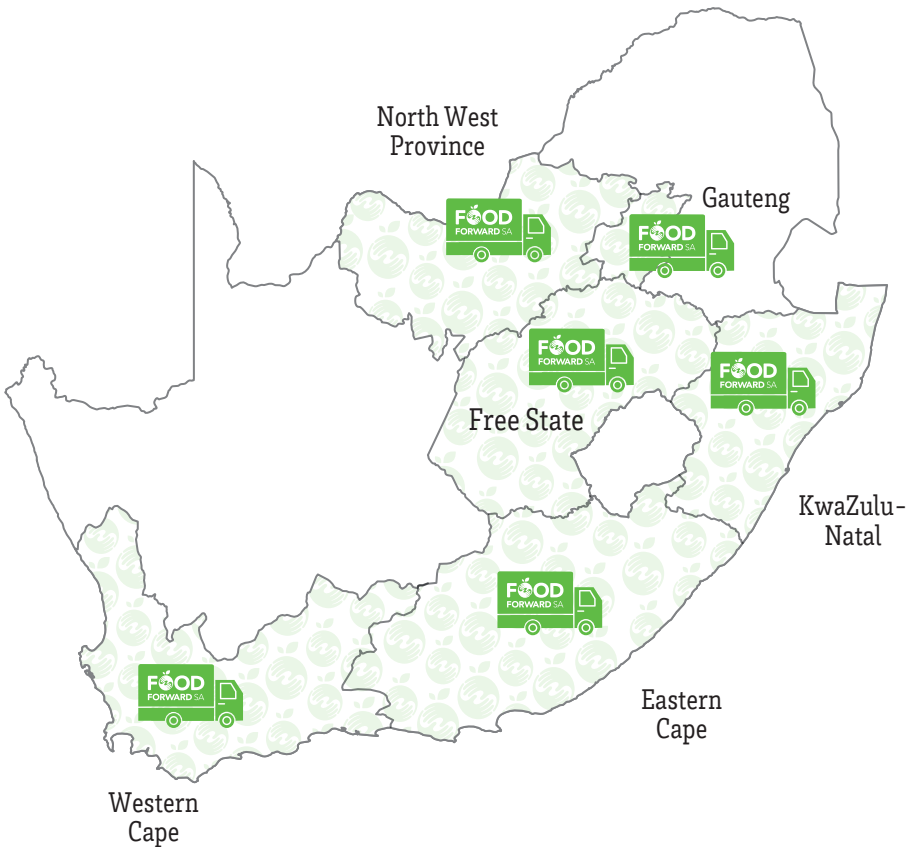

OUR VISION

A South Africa without hunger.

OUR MISSION

To reduce hunger in South Africa by safely and cost-effectively securing quality food, and making it available to those who need it.

One third of all food produced in South Africa is wasted while more than 14 million people go without adequate food to meet their basic needs.

Established in 2009 to address widespread hunger in South Africa, FoodForward SA connects a world of excess to a world of need by recovering edible surplus food from farmers, manufacturers, and retailers, for redistribution to registered beneficiary organisations that serve the poor. We call this cost-effective model Foodbanking.

FoodForward SA is the largest food redistribution charity in South Africa, and part of a global movement focussed on alleviating hunger and reducing the environmental impact by diverting good quality edible surplus food.

Our Programmes

1 Warehouse Foodbanking

We source, collect, and store edible surplus food from the supply chain and redistribute this food to registered Beneficiary Organisations (BOs) across South Africa that use the groceries to prepare meals.

2 FoodShare/Virtual Foodbanking

We developed our own digital technology platform called FoodShare that virtually connects beneficiary organisations to retail stores and food outlets for the regular collection and reporting of surplus food.

3 Second Harvest

More than 50% of our agricultural produce is wasted. Second Harvest is our outreach programme to commercial farmers, allowing them to donate their post-harvest surplus produce to fight hunger.

Second Harvest has drastically improved the nutritional value of the food we recover. Where huge volumes are donated, we partner with manufacturers to produce shelf-stable products like jams and sauces.

4 Mobile Rural Depots

In order to ensure greater access to food to vulnerable rural communities, FoodForward SA set up the Mobile Rural Depot (MRD) model. We select vulnerable rural communities across South Africa, and we provide beneficiary organisations with monthly food provisions.

5 Supply Chain Youth Internship

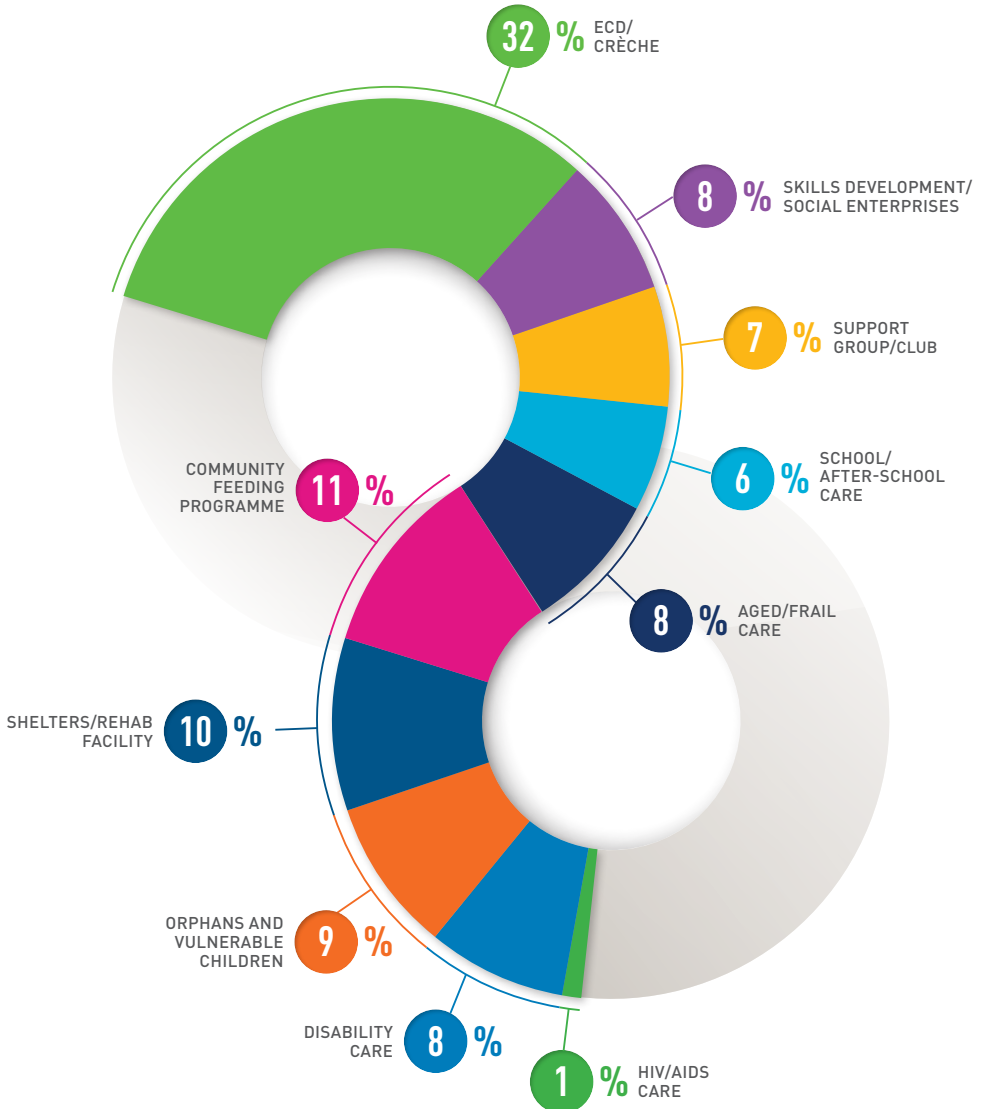
The supply chain is a huge barrier to entry for underprivileged youth. In an effort to reduce youth unemployment and equip them with skills and experience, we started a SETA accredited 6 month Supply Chain Youth Internship, and aim to get them absorbed by one of our supply chain partners.

6 Large-scale Feeding Programmes

In partnership with various corporates we provide nutritious breakfast cereals and milk to 50,000 children in crèches, as well as primary and secondary schools.

OUR BENEFICIARY ORGANISATIONS

Adequate nutrition is the basis for all social development. FoodForward SA is part of an ecosystem that uses edible surplus food as a catalyst for sustainable social change. More than 75% of our BO network focus on education, care for vulnerable children, youth and women's empowerment. Our surplus food strategies strengthen existing communities and significantly reduce our beneficiary organisations' expenditure on food groceries.



FOODBANKING: AN ENVIRONMENTAL SOLUTION

Reducing food waste and loss is the third most effective solution for fighting climate change. For every ton of food we recover, 4 tons of greenhouse gas emissions are saved.

Last year FoodForward SA recovered 4,200 tons of food, which is equivalent to the saving 3,700 passenger vehicles driven for a year, or the annual electricity usage of 6,000 households.
