WHAT ARE WE ACHIEVING?

EDUCATION

- **Full-Time Scholarships:** Since 2012, GPFA has rewarded **490** scholarships to underprivileged boys & girls.
- **Emergency Funding:** Since 2014, GPFA has awarded financial assistance to **110** organizations & **40** individuals.
- **Book Bag Drive:** Since 2016, GPFA has awarded book bags, school stationaries, and **20 USD** each to 1,238 underprivileged students in Ghana and Liberia.

LEADERSHIP

- **Young Women Leadership Program:** Since 2016, GPFA has equipped **109** girls with the needed skills to excel as great leaders.
- **Peace Through FairPlay:** Since 2013, GPFA has impacted **240** young Liberians to become peace advocates in their communities & schools.
- **PeaceJam Conference:** Since 2016, GPFA has hosted **3** peace conferences which mentored & inspired **1,614** students to find inspirations through the work of Nobel Peace Laureates.

COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT

- **Breakfast Walk 'N' Talk:** Since 2016, GPFA has fostered safe & networking spaces for **1,266** women and girls.
- **Feminist Lecture Series:** Since 2017, GPFA has empowered **1,221** people through its lecture series that encourage healthy dialogues about Liberia's society.
- **Liberian Women Lead:** This 2-year project mobilized **330** rural and urban women to engage with key stakeholders to advocate for gender equality and the realization of women's rights in Liberia.
- **Sustain the Peace:** Women and youth-led campaigns, which connected **19,000** Liberians to ensure Liberia's fragile peace is sustained.
