Started in 2016 for above 18 boys the rehab center provides short-term dormitory accommodation and food for 40 youth who have secured employment in local industries or are pursuing higher education or skill based courses. **Beneficiaries (40)**



Earth Studio :

Inaugurated in 2012, this brain child of artists Manjiri and Mangesh Kute. This is an On-site vocational training centre which provides a creative and rehabilitative space for our beneficiaries to learn and build upon their artistic and commercial skills. Hands on training of Clay work, terracotta articles like jewelry, block printing, natural dying, stitching, embroidery along with the experience in managing budgets, production and marketing is given.



Krushimitra :

Designed to train aspiring youth to be 'Krushimitra' & impart training to small and medium farmers in organic farming and apply advanced farming techniques in their farms, organizing Farmer fairs, helping farmers to use various applications, guiding them to avail various govt. schemes **Beneficiaries (40)**

We have promoted girls' education through three campaigns with Malala Fund reaching over 30,000 people in our district.

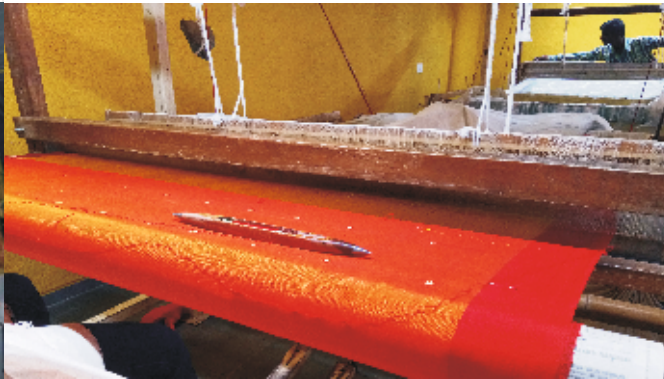


Snehalaya with Paani Foundation :

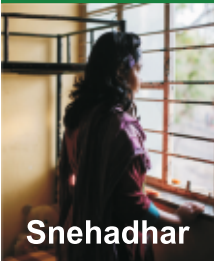

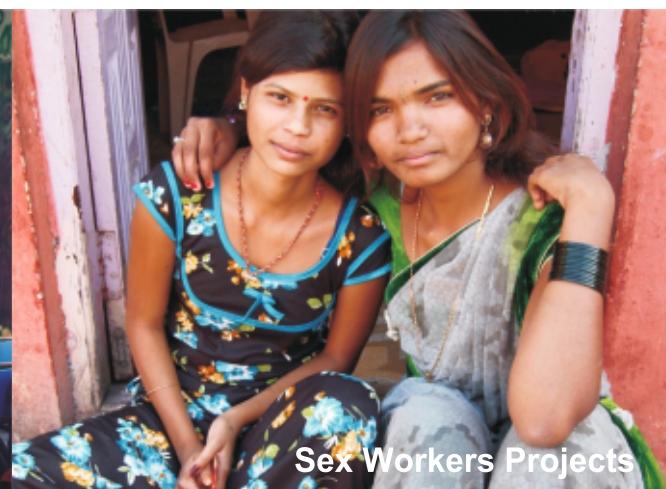
