BACKGROUND

HUMANE-AID FOR COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION (HACO) is a Non-Governmental Organization which was founded on 14th September 2014. HACO is officially registered by the Ministry of Justice, Relief & Rehabilitation and is a registered member of the South Sudan NGO Forum which is an independent coordinating body.

The mission of HACO: is to engage itself in non-profit activities on nonprofit purpose, strengthen and promote the communities' capacities through capacity building in entrepreneurial skills, engender peace and security, access to justice, inclusive education support, Hygiene, water and Sanitation, SGBV, Health, nutrition, Food Security and livelihoods.

HACO's core values are: Gender sensitivity; Co-operation; Mutual respect and trust; Honesty; Transparency and accountability and Participatory approaches in development.

HACO's strategy: is to work across South Sudan where communities are suffering and recovering from disaster, conflict, post – conflict economic hardships by helping communities move rapidly from crisis to long term durable solutions and continue to provide assistance until we are no longer needed.
