BACKGROUND

Rehabilitation of Amputee is a major problem in Nigeria. Today, there is no verified database of people with limb loss either as a result of trauma, diabetic mellitus or other reasons. At the moment, efforts towards Amputee rehabilitation in Nigeria is largely uncoordinated. Thus, Aderonke Rehabilitation Network (ARN) is dedicated to restoring hope of Amputees in Nigeria as well as empowering them achieve their full potentials with quality prosthetic device, education and advocacy. We achieve this through the generous support of the public and donations of used prosthetic parts from foreign partners.

ABOUT US

In 2018, Aderonke Rehabilitation Network started as a non-registered charity program by the founder, Aderonke Oguntuase; and supported by the secretary, Florence Marcus, with a sole objective of receiving used prosthetic parts from American agencies to support indigent Amputees in Nigeria. At the beginning, 16 indigent amputees were assessed by a prosthetist at Primus P&O Department, Abuja, to benefits from the expected prosthetic parts from the USA. After several months, the parts were not forthcoming. To achieve our focus of hope restoration, passion and expand our scope, Aderonke Rehabilitation Network became a registered organization.
