About

Queen Laura Foundation started its operations in January 2017 and was incorporated in 2019 as a non-profit organisation, in response to the millions of children suffering from all kinds of sexual abuse by preserving their life and preventing family disintegration through the social developmental approach. Since its establishment, Queen Laura Foundation objective has been building communities in South Africa where all abused and disadvantaged children, women and orphans, live with a loving adult care giver in a safe family home with easy access to food, healthcare, education, recreation, emotional support and ensuring that they have the opportunity to reach their full potential.

As part of our social work services, we started building a care center for sexually abused children in the informal settlement of Leeuwfontein Baviaanspoort South Africa. Our care center will also accommodate abused women and also children from disadvantaged families will be given a meal and send to school at no cost.

Queen Laura Foundation means Hope for Leeuwfontien Baviaanspoort Community. Therefore it symbolizes the new beginning that we provide South Africa children.

What we do Child Safety and Education

Despite efforts to achieve a multi-disciplinary, intersectorial approach to the criminal justice process, very few rapists are charged due to lack of forensic evidence presented in court (e.g. dockets go missing, reports are poorly written, police go on leave, caregivers are not informed of legal process). Operation Child safety and education seeks to promote a structure to enable communities to monitor, intervene and assist the criminal justice process to assert the best interests of a child victim of sexual abuse, from point-of-rescue to court hearing (minimum 2 years) whilst we provide shelter and education. Using therapeutic methods to obtain forensic evidence, our Child Safety Officer (CSO) collaborates with the criminal justice system to ensure the rights of a child victim of sexual abuse. Oueen Laura Foundation provides a holistic set of services to the survivors of child sexual abuse.

School Outreach Program

With the use of specially designed Edu-toys, Queen Laura Foundation provides age-appropriate HIV/AIDS education and awareness to children at local primary schools. Queen Laura Foundation recognises the importance of educating children about HIV/AIDS at an early age to prevent the risk of infection. In addition, Queen Laura Foundation uses this programme to educate teachers and school staff about sexual abuse and HIV/AIDS and to identify sexually abused children in the communities.

Rescue Centre Program

The hub of Operation Queen Laura Foundation is The Queen Laura Foundation Rescue Centre where all of our activities and projects are based. The centre also functions as a drop-in centre, a counselling facility and a community help desk for child sexual abuse. The centre provides a safe haven and a home to children who are seeking refuge from abuse and their abusers.

Support Group Program

Every Saturday morning Queen aura Foundation sees all victims from the previous weeks' cases at our center for various forms of therapy with the councilors or inhouse Psychologists. This is an on-going programme throughout the year and gives victims of rape, sexual abuse and any other form of violence the chance to get together and speak about their trauma. This is a free service to our child victims and their families

Why we do this

Many South Africa families lack the financial stability to provide their children with daily protection against sexual abuse. Consequently, children and women undergoes many disorders like post-traumatic stress disorder, anxiety disorder, and depression. This results in child abuse, potentially affecting the child's entire life by stunting their brain and well-being and the children not being able to achieve their full potential. Queen Laura Foundation try to give children and women hope and encourage them to reach their full potential, we want to build a Rescue Centre for the sexually abused children in the informal settlement of leauwfontien Baviaanspoort A to accommodate 120 abused and homeless children and women.
