# WHAT WE DO

## FOOD ASSISTANCE

**The Free Market** – A weekly, market style food assistance program where all are welcome to shop our store shelves for food and other specialty items they may need for the week. Our food selection varies by week, based on donations and food bank purchases.

**Vegantry** – A pop-up market style plant-based food assistance program focused on providing fresh produce and healthier food options for those in need.

## MEAL ASSISTANCE

We carefully curate emergency food boxes for individuals who are not able to attend our Free Market. During the holiday season, we assemble and provide Thanksgiving boxed meals on the Monday before the holiday to provide food for warm memories and cheer.

## SERVICE PROGRAMS

In addition to providing food and meal assistance, we offer homeless outreach, a clothing closet, career learning center and more.
