The ANAMBRA STATE ASSOCIATION WOMEN IN USA INC. also known as the ASA WOMEN USA is a registered 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization for charitable purposes. ASA Women USA, Inc. was borne out of the vision to create a platform that advocates for healthcare access to indigent women with cancer & other maternal health concerns in Nigeria; provides cancer advocacy, awareness and education in USA and in Nigeria. The goal of the organization is to consistently advocate to help improve access to health Insurance through adoption and enrollment of indigent women in the Anambra State Health Insurance Scheme and high quality cancer screening, diagnosis, treatments within Anambra State, Nigeria and in USA, through investment in the proposed International Comprehensive Cancer center in Anambra State, Nigeria. The cancer center will focus on cancer screening, diagnosis that includes pathology, laboratory services and medical imaging and for Treatments that includes cancer surgery, chemotherapy, radiotherapy and immunotherapy, with the goal to optimize seamless access to quality care. Consistent with ASA Women USA mission and legacy project, the organization is seeking for Public-Private Partnerships (PPP) funding for the expansion of a community's hospital that will include the International Comprehensive Cancer Centre in Anambra State, Nigeria.

Core Competencies

ASA Women USA. Inc. Legacy Project @GlobalGiving is the Healthcare Access to Indigent Women in Nigeria. Our project focuses on providing life-saving enrollment of one hundred Indigent Anambra Women with Cancer & Maternal Health Issues in the Anambra State Health Insurance Scheme for a minimum of five years and support the establishment of the International Comprehensive Cancer Centre in the Piloted Amichi Diocesan Hospital, Anambra State, Nigeria.

Through this project, we have enrolled over seventy Anambra Women with Breast & Cervical Cancers & other Maternal Health concerns in the Anambra State Health Insurance Scheme; and working towards the remodeling and renovating of the existing wing of the Piloted Amichi Diocesan Hospital, to get the International Comprehensive Cancer Centre running within a time frame of five years.

ASA Women USA engages in fundraising activities through Global Giving Campaigns; Grants; 5K Walk/Run for Hope & Fight to End Cancer. Funds raised are earmarked as follows: 65% of Funds raised will go towards the establishment of the International Comprehensive Cancer Centre; while 35% of funds will enroll more Anambra Women with cancer & maternal health issues in the yearly Anambra State health insurance scheme for a minimum of five years; provide cancer awareness; advocacy and education
