# ★VETERANS RESOURCE CENTER★

*Monday-Friday 7:30 am-4:30 pm*

Anyone who has served even one day in uniform (except dishonorable discharge) is eligible for our services. We provide:

- Breakfast, lunch
- Supportive services including:
  - Job assistance
  - Computer skills training
  - Addiction recovery assistance
  - Financial literacy training

# TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM

*A supportive community for Homeless Veterans*

The Transitional Housing Program at Veterans Place provides a supportive and sober living environment for up to 48 Veterans at our campus on Washington Boulevard near Pittsburgh's Highland Park. With 13 townhouses arranged with 48 single-room-occupancy units, residents at Veterans Place enjoy the camaraderie and sense of community that comes from living among fellow Veterans.

# EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

Funded through the Department of Labor, HVRP allows our Employment Team to work 1 on 1 with veterans to reintegrate back into the workforce and obtain gainful employment. We partner with other agencies to provide wrap around services to simultaneously address the complex challenges facing veterans, including training, housing, transportation and clothing assistance. ## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

### **Any Veteran with**

- *Discharge condition other than dishonorable*
- *Copy of their DD-214*
- *Homeless or at-risk at time of assessment*

## VETS PLACE SUCCESS

- Served 380 unique veterans
- placed 78% of veterans into permanent housing
- \$.92 cents of every dollar goes straight to the program
- Found 82% of our Vets competitive employment.
