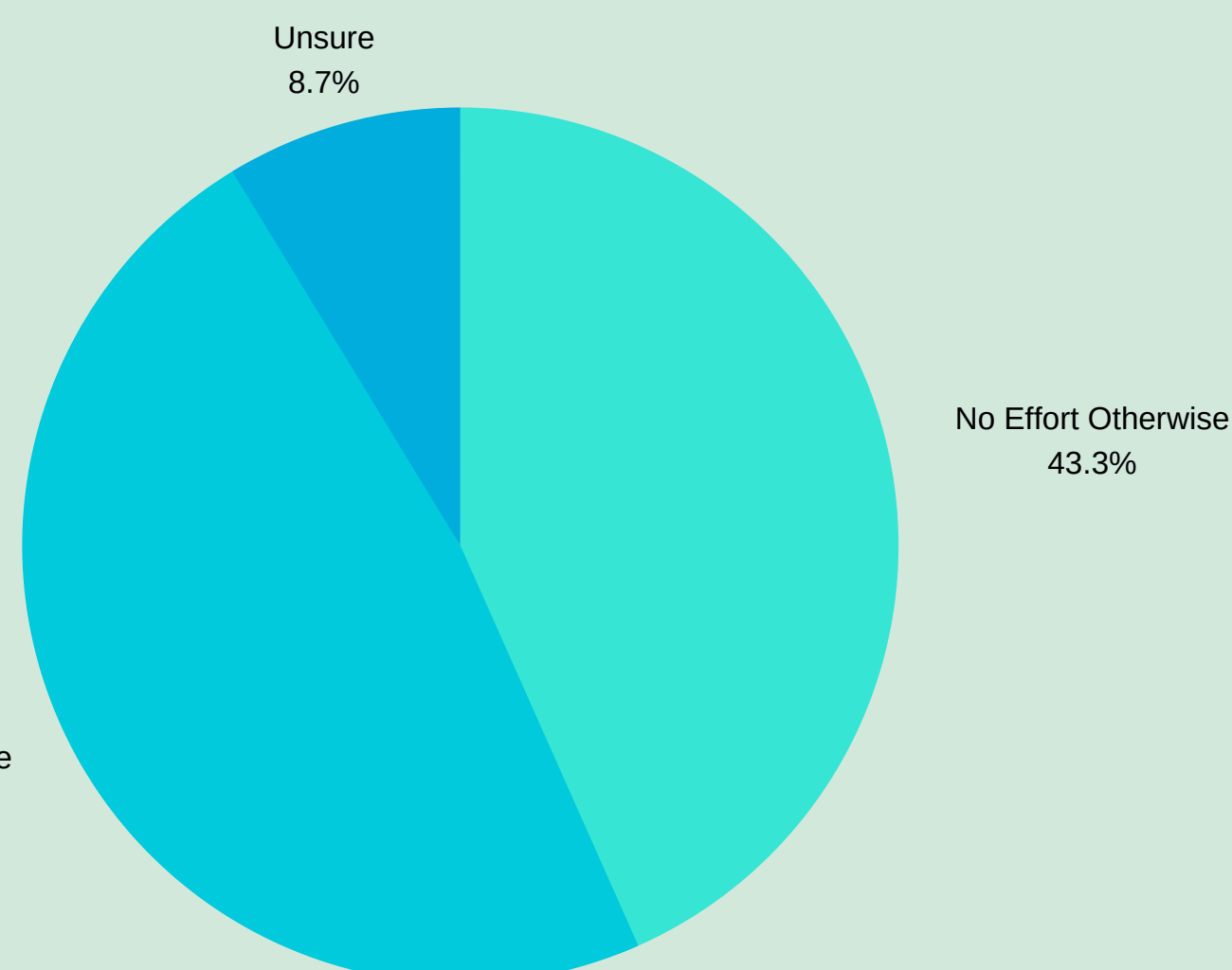
Monitoring and Evaluation Report

1. Program Expansion

Our program **doubled** in 2019. Now, we host two thirty-person seminars of Israelis and Palestinians.

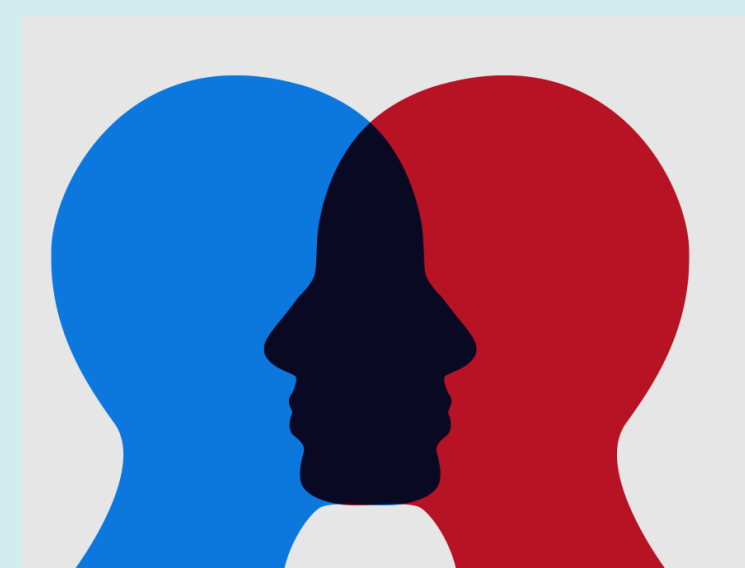
2. Non-Traditional Peacebuilders

More than 40% of participants indicated that they would not have made an effort to meet the other side were it not for Tech2Peace.



3. Increased Empathy and Understanding

By the Davis Measure of Cognitive Empathy, cognitive empathy increased by an average of 1.06 points out of 5,



4. New Friendships

96% of participants said that they made meaningful relationships with other people during the seminars.



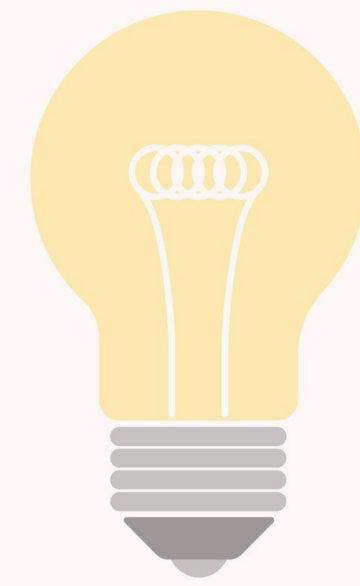
5. Sharing Ideas at Home

82.4% plan to share what they learned through the seminars with their trusted circles at home.



7. Entrepreneurial Spirit

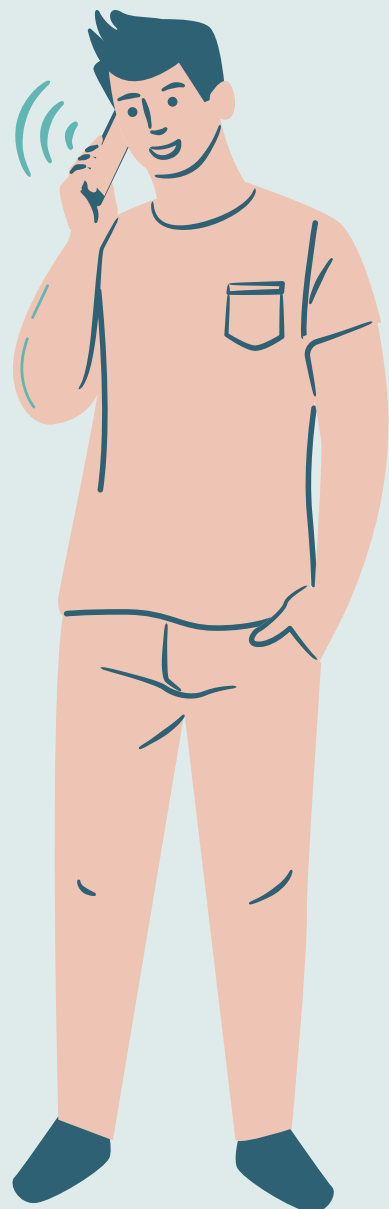
100% of Tech2Peace participants who applied to the 50-50 Startup Incubator program made it past the first round.



6. Continued Engagement

61% of participants indicated interest in the volunteer program.

90% indicated interest in community events.
