ORGANISATION PROFILE

History

SAHAWA Youth Development organization, formally known as SAHAWA Youth Organisation came into was at the eve of the millennium in 1999. The organization was founded by some aged group of youth concerns about outbreak of fallen standard of education, disease and decline of moral values in Tukuntawa community. The name of SAHAWA is derived from Arabic language meaning awareness. The organization started with five members later grown to thirteen. The members started meeting in an open place, on weekly basis to discuss ways forward in addressing the identified issues. Currently, the organization is been manage by nine member executive board members and the membership grown to 70 youth. (Voluntary members)

The organization Registered with Kano State government in 2003 under state ministry of Information, Youth and sports (as CBO) and later registered with Corporate Affairs Commission, Nigeria on the 10th of July 2008.

Mission

With Dedication and Enthusiasm we shall consistently strive to improve quality of life among Nigerian youth and children.

Vision

To install in young people, self confidence, compassion, love for the less privileged, sense of discipline and respect and good governance.



Goal

To achieve qualitative education and entrepreneurial skills in cur state and Nigeria at large for self reliance and development.

Objectives

The organization has the following objectives;

- To support and promote the activities of education among young people and children.
- Encouraging young people into self employment and entre preneurship.
- Encouraging young people to adhere to their religious teachings.
- Initiate the operation and management of non-profit and profit making projects in support of youth development.
- Develop, promote, encourage and foster co-operation among registered youth organizations in Kano state Nigeria and world at larges.

Programs

Currently the Organization is running educational programs with over 2000 beneficiaries cutting across all age group of people which include:

Sahawa International School (Nursery and Primary School)

The school is established in 2008 is aimed at providing the organisation with funds necessary for day-to-day running of affairs for sustainability. We teach according to the national curriculum provided by the Federal Government of Nigeria. The school has ten teaching staff, two gatemen and two nannies. Currently, we have total enrolment of 300 pupils. This school has won prizes in excellent teaching services and has got recognition among parent. The school runs from 8am until 12:45pm Monday to Friday.

Sahawa Islamiyya School for young people and children

This school has total enrolment of 2875 pupils learning various aspects of Islamic teaching. The major subjects thought are Qu'anic education, Islamic (Fiqh) Jurisprudence, Tawheed (Monotheism), Hadeeth, History of



the prophets, Morals, Arabic and general studies in Islam. This section has twenty classes run by 74 youth as teachers run voluntarily. This young people serving as teachers are the members of the organisation. We run periodic training for the teaching staff to enhance their efficiency in the field. The school is as old as the organisation established since year 1999. Since inception, the Sahawa Islamiyya has recorded two ceremonious Qur'anic graduations which were witnessed by his Highness, the emir of Kano Alh. (DR). Ado Bayero.

Sahawa Islamiyya school for women

This school was established in 2005 with eight students. Now we have the total enrolment of 150 students. The teaching subjects remain the same as the above Islamiyya School only that this focuses on adult education. This section has ten teaching staff and has recorded a great success

Sahawa Library Service

In order to encourage reading habit and research among young people of our community, Sahawa Youth Organisation has opened a community modern library in partnership with the British Council and British High Commission, Abuja Nigeria. The library has 867 books across various discipline and fields of life particularly heath, entrepreneurship skills, drama and many more. This library has the capacity of 20 people at a time and its equipped with high speed computer for easy access of materials. This service is voluntary with nothing to join. Our major aim is to encourage reading habits among young people, children and even adult.

Sahawa Extra Mural Lesson (Runs voluntarily on the weekend for Nursery, Primary and Secondary School)

This program was designed to help the less privileged children in the society whose parent could afford their education and those in the public primary and secondary schools. This program has made the organisation to be popularly known among people and has recorded a huge success since inception in 2000. In this section, the organisation was able to trained young people (female among other group) to have a sound qualitative education in English, Mathematics, Sciences, General studies,

Arts, and Business commerce. Since program has helped our children a lot in securing admission into various higher institutions of learning making our youth becoming more responsible and productive in the society.

Sahawa Centre for Information Technology

The centre provides Certificate and Diploma in Information Technology for sustainability of our programs. The centre also provides free basic computer training programs for its members. The main aim of the centre is to provide subsidize IT education. Since inception in 2008, the centre has trained 35 people as certified IT personnel.

Sahawa Adult Education for Women

This part of Sahawa was established in the year 2007, with the aim of providing free Western education to the illiterate women in our locality. At present the section has 45 women in the register and more than 75 women have benefited so far from the programme.

Sahawa Qur'anic Memorization School

Sahawa organisation is establishing this programme to help children to memorize the Holy Qur'an which is the primary source of Sharia in our community. Also this programme will go a long way in upbringing youth of high quality in our society at large.
