Project title- Trauma care center for stray animals and birds

Project summary-

This project facilitates free of cost treatment, care, and rehabilitation of rescued, abandoned, diseased and distressed animals and birds in the city of Ahmedabad, with the rapid urbanization animals and birds are facing great threats to survive. Loss of their own habitats, lack of adequate food and nutrition, decent shelter, proper medication in various seasonal and zoonotic ailments are forcing them to either die or live a miserable life in the human-dominated areas. Our 'Trauma Care Center' project aims to help the animals and birds that are suffering by providing timely treatment and care to them, also, spread awareness amongst the local communities and the future generation to improve the welfare and conservation.

We have established two multi-specialty hospitals n and rehabilitation center for animals and birds separately under the same roof, Where, on an average we treat over 3000 – 4000 animals and birds in a month. We also drive an 'Anti Rabies' vaccination program with an aim of a rabies free society where strays and humans can successfully co-exist.

Project objectives-;

- Humanely reduce the stray population through Animal Birth Control
- Alleviate suffering of injured animals through our prompt and specialized treatment
- Eliminate rabies deaths in our community through vaccinations and education
- Aware the community on Animal Welfare
- Promote coexistence with animals and nature.
- Create a humane environment for animals with direct benefits to the communities
- Provide therapy for disabled animals and birds
- Find forever homes for rescued and abandoned animals

Budget- \$ 240000

What is the problem?

Fast urbanization is causing habitat degradation and other issues in urban areas. Animals have been left on the streets with no access to food, water or shelter, they are being found in a pitiable state of neglect. Most of them are extremely dehydrated, starving, or diseased with seasonal infections or injured from deadly road accidents or victim of cruelty. Every day we receive the patients with various ailments like fracture, tumor, cancer, flu, skin infection, allergies etc. Free roaming animals are often inhumanely treated in misguided attempts to eliminate diseases such as rabies, anthrax, tuberculosis, influenza, many untreated ailments have resulted in various infections, and sometimes these infections can lead to disease outbreak and pose a danger to humans.

How you will solve the problem?

Jivdaya Charitable Trust opens all the 365 days in a year. We have 74 dedicated staff including 11 full time veterinarians. Outpatient Department (OPD) remains working from 09:30 am to 06:00 pm for treating stray animals and birds. The patients who require long term supervision or surgery are admitted at our facility as an indoor patient, for further treatment and care. We have capacity of accommodating over 150 animals including cats, dogs, rabbits etc and around 1500 birds at a time. Apart from that, we also nurture orphan and abandoned animals and birds. This project will improve animal welfare of un-owned, free roaming animals and birds living in human dominated areas in urban as well as rural setting. We will provide care and comfort to suffering animals and birds through veterinary interventions for diseases, and injuries. One important aspect of this project will be prevention of various zoonotic diseases like rabies, anthrax, tuberculosis, influenza, etc. by vaccinating animals in Ahmedabad and in turn improving public health.

Potential long term impact?

- Improving animal welfare in communities.
- Prevention and control of rabies, a deadly virus that kills more than 18,000-20,000 people every year in India.
- Prevention and control of various zoonotic and seasonal diseases like Rabies, Canine Distemper, parvovirus, anthrax, tuberculosis, influenza etc by our special vaccination program to keep the society and communities healthy and worry free.
- Control in dog and cat population by our 'animal birth control program' to keep the existing population healthy and avoid all the hazardous incidents like road accidents, animal cruelty due to the overpopulation.
- Saving thousands of birds injured by Glass coated thread(manja) during the kite flying festival(Uttarayan) every year and contributing to nature conservation
- Saving avian lives means saving our environment as they help in balancing the eco system by controlling pests, rodents, maggots and many more.
- Water birds help to maintain the wetland healthy by keeping it clean
