Career Girls Club offers school counselors an all-inclusive program, including lesson plans, measurement and evaluation tools, activities, and supplies to work with students to better understand career possibilities and the soft skills required for success. Topics and themes are explored by pairing Career Girls role model videos with a discussion-based curriculum and optional activities. Career Girls Club offers a 20-week curriculum that you can customize to any length to fit your needs. The Career Girls team provides virtual training for school staff to lead the clubs and provides all materials free of charge to participating schools.

WHO: School counselors facilitate sessions with elementary, middle, or high school girls.

WHAT: School-based club where girls develop a greater understanding of career possibilities and the soft skills required for success.

WHEN: Weekly sessions structured for an advisory, lunchtime, or after-school program.

WHERE: Career Girls Club is available as a school-based program for accredited elementary, middle, and high schools.

HOW: School counselors may attend a virtual training on how to use Career Girls Empowerment Videos paired with discussion and group activities. School counselors administer a measurement and evaluation tool before and after the 20-week program. School principal and parent/guardian permission is required.
