# We provide solutions to the problem of access to drinking water

Prioritizing rural communities, we work hard, focusing on provinces with less access to mains water and sewage systems. To reach a solution, it is essential to have a thorough knowledge of the problem.

# What is the quality of water rural families in Argentina are drinking?

Knowing the quality of water means analyzing its physical and chemical characteristics. Despite the high cost of this process, we consider it essential to take samples and have them analyzed by specialized laboratories. With the results, a precise diagnosis on the quality of the water consumed by the communities can be made.

These results are compared with the human consumption standards established by competent organizations (WHO, Argentine Food Code, etc.)

Starting from this diagnosis, we lead an educational process in which the families concerned become aware of the problem, can size and act on it, then propose concrete answer through technical solutions for the infrastructures: cisterns, wells, reservoirs, filter and others.



## The water problem

## 3 out of 10

people on the planet do not have access to "properly managed" water, i.e.: free of contamination.



## 2.1 billion

people around the world suffer from this shortcoming, which has a direct impact on health indicators.

### 20 million

Argentinians have no sewers, and 80% of waste water is discharged into rivers and streams without being treated.



#### **1 out of 10**

Argentinians live in an area where the water is contaminated with arsenic.

## 361.000

boys and girls under the age of 5 die from diarrhea every year around the world. This is equal to 2 children every 3 minutes (WHO - UNICEF).

## 7 million

Argentinians do not have a public drinking water supply. The lowest coverage is found in rural areas.
