

PROPOSAL TO BUY THE PLACE FOR THE CHILDREN OF JANANI HOME

The Janani Home for Girls came into existence in 2013 to support abandoned girl children of Puducherry and neighbouring districts of Tamil Nadu. The Home was started with 10 children. The Department of Social Welfare after making due diligence study provided us licence to run the home. The home was brought under their affiliation. The Child Welfare Committee and Juvenile Justice Board are also agencies who regularly monitor the home and provide guidance and support.

The home was placed in rented buildings all these days. We face the following difficulties in keeping the home in a rented building:

- a. Huge rent and deposit is being paid and it takes away all our savings pay huge rent.
- b. The land lords enhance the rent every year making us very difficult to meet our expenses.
- c. We pay hefty payments for maintenance of the building.
- d. Due to shifting of our home often, we need to change the schools for the children and to make arrangements for transportation.
- e. While shifting, we have to change the address in all the records.

Now, the home is shifted to a nice place at No.19, Veeramamunivar Street, Colas Nagar, Puducherry-1. The land lord of the new building who lives in France, is kind enough to sell this house to us. The cost would be around \$420000.
