## BETTER STUDY ENVIRONMENT FOR BETTER EDUCATE GENERATION

The Governorate of Marib is one of many areas affected by the ongoing conflict in Yemen, the school buildings and equipment are heavily affected which directly affected the students and the education system as a whole, The schools don't have enough chairs, desks, boards nor tools to enable the students to study.



The Ministry of Education has taken the first step by providing the displaced person camp in Al Jafinah in Marib City with three tents to be used as classrooms but there were missing all the required equipment to make them function. Now upon receiving the basic equipment, Alweheda school which is a primary level school, is able to provide through its two shifts for boys and girls to total of 1680 students (856 male and 824 females students) with its services.



As part of its social responsibilities, YFCA self-funded project has coordinated with the Ministry of Education office in Marib, to provide these classes with double chairs desks, in addition to whiteboards.

YFCA believes that education is the most important sustainable tool for human rights which promotes for a stronger Yemeni civil society. It can promote peace, security and ultimately prevent future conflicts.
