1. Introduction

Dakbhanga-Bangladesh (DBD) is a non-government organization. It is registered with NGO Affairs Bureau of Bangladesh Government in 2004.

The initiative was started in 1998 through voluntary activities of some friends of Bangladesh and Belgium in remote Dakbhanaga Village of Ramu Upazilla Under Cox's Bazar District which is isolated from mainland by Bakkhali River, hilly lands and nearby forests. Afterwards, the initiatives was registered in Belgium as a Charity Organization and also started its journey in Bangladesh through taking registration from NGO Affairs Bureau.

Since establishment, DBD has been implementing education project focusing Child rights promotion at Ramu upazilla of Cox's Bazar district through establishing two Primary schools.
