

UN Migration's Response to Venezuela Budget Outline

USA for IOM Fundraising Target: USD 1 million

The UN's Response for Venezuela needs USD 1.44 Billion to provide humanitarian assistance to the 5.9 million Venezuelans living outside their country as refugees and migrants. Funds raised by USA for IOM will support this critical effort.

See below the breakdown, by selected categories of humanitarian assistance, for the funds needed to reach target beneficiaries, and USA for IOM's planned contribution towards this effort.
