As many as **40 million people** worldwide are trapped in modern slavery, earning traffickers **\$150 billion annually**.

**4.8 million** are trafficked for sexual exploitation — bringing in **\$99 billion** of the **total profits**.

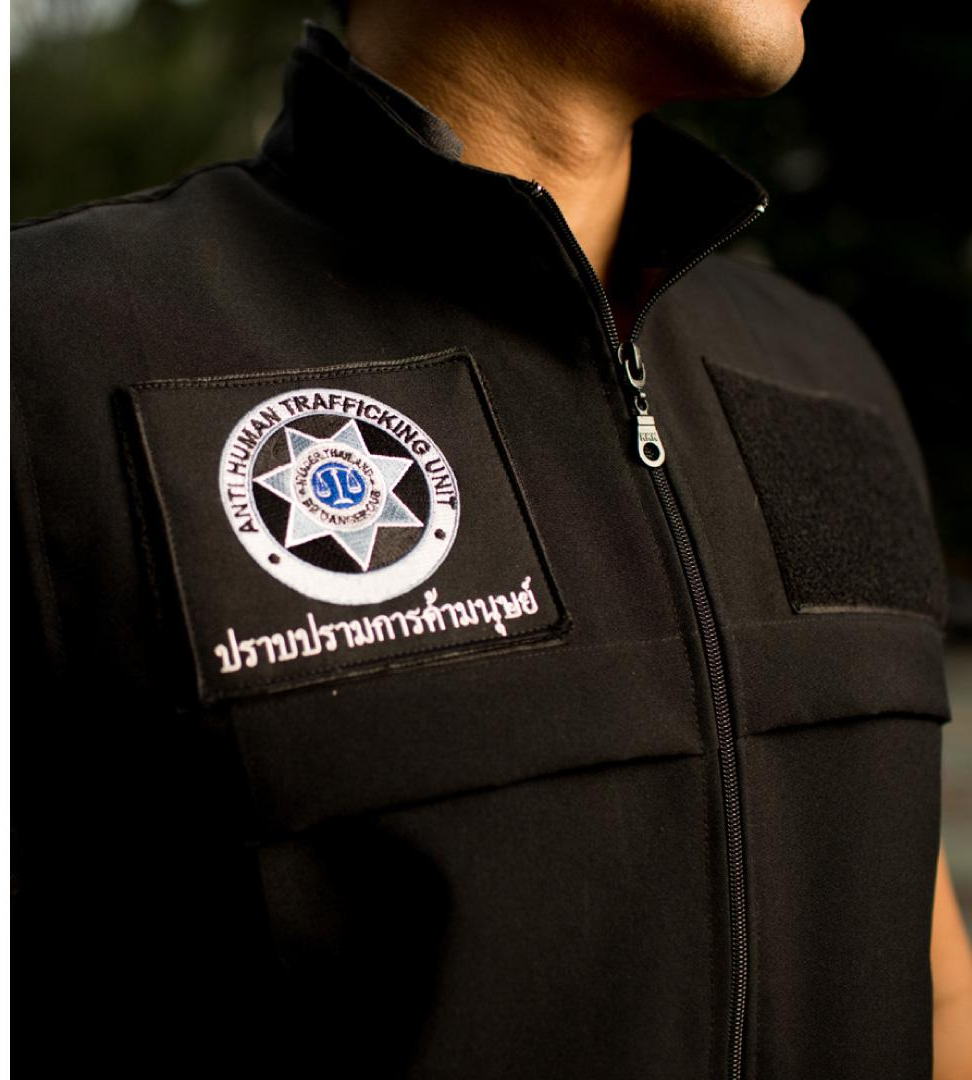


## Partner with Law Enforcement

Ensure safe removal of victims from exploitation.

Implement thorough investigation so **critical data is collected** for **prosecution and conviction of criminals.**

Prioritize the needs and welfare of the victim.

## **Support Survivors**

Protect the welfare of survivors during police interviews.

Provide the protection of a social worker to walk with survivors throughout the legal process.

Facilitate connections to aftercare services.



# Prosecute Traffickers

Provide strong legal representation for victims.

Protect victims' rights during the criminal justice process.

Pursue compensation on a victim's behalf.

*Prosecution creates a powerful deterrent that drives traffickers and child sex offenders out of business and prevents further victims from being trafficked.*

is Operation Blackwrist.

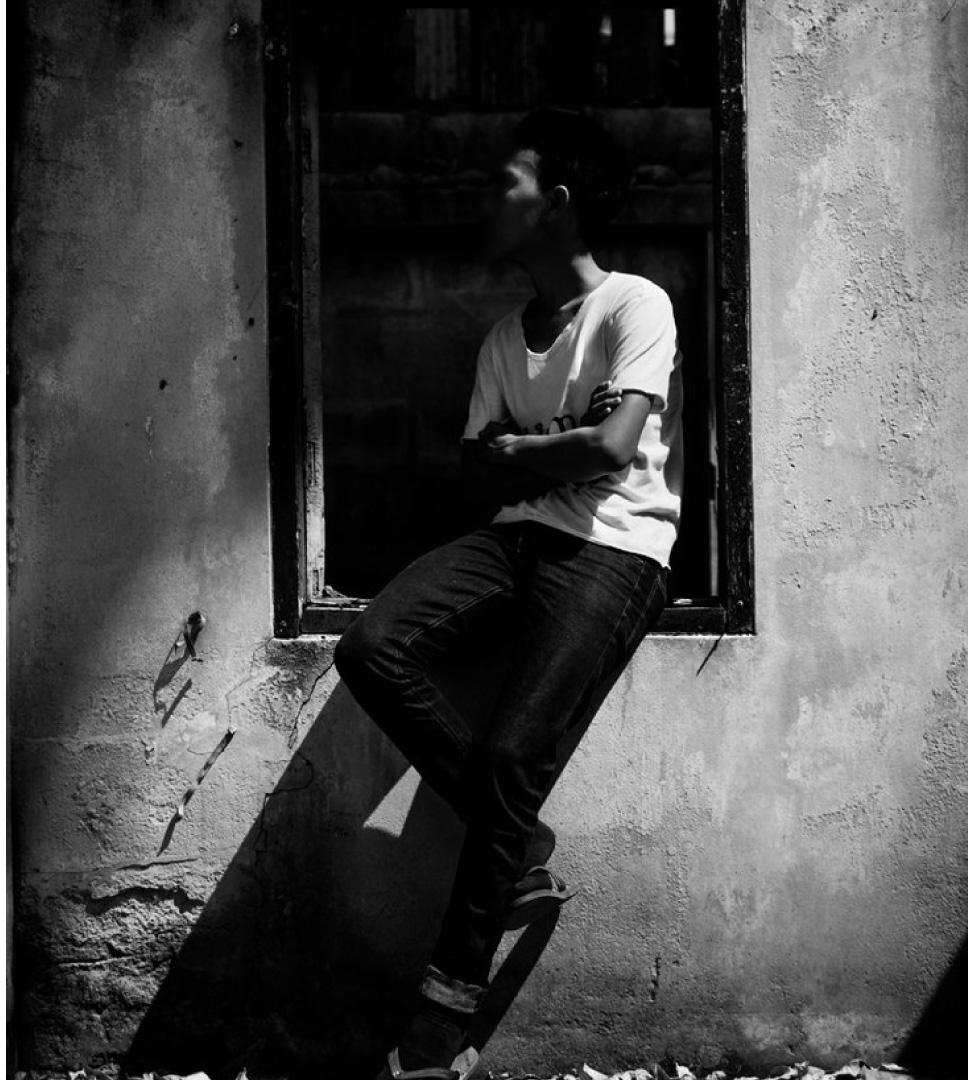
Since the operation 41 more children have

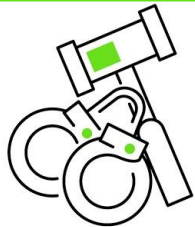
# OPERATION R

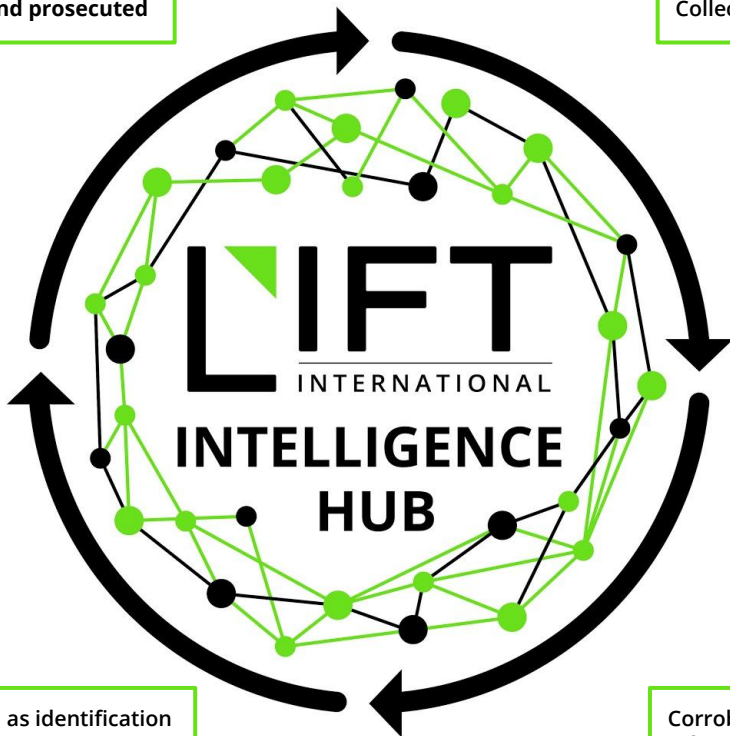

# A Proven Method

## In 2020, LIFT International:

- Assisted 103 survivors
- Aided in the arrests of 63 offenders
- Sentenced offenders to 1,297 years of combined prison time

## Since 2011:

- 553 survivors assisted
- \$1,000,000 in compensation ordered to survivors
- \$50,000,000 in assets seized
- 3,187 years of prison time sentenced

## **GAPS AND OPPORTUNITIES TO ADDRESS THEM**

### **Gaps**

Significant number of law enforcement personnel with limited capacity to identify victims of human trafficking and offenders and awareness to prevent further trauma to the victim upon identification.

Gaps between anti-human trafficking laws and actual events on the ground.

Lack of awareness on the dangers of human trafficking and knowledge to report it within communities.

### **Opportunities to address these problems**

Long-standing partnerships with NGO and law enforcement to investigate cases, support victims and engage communities.

Highly competent, professional technical experts within LIFT to support partners and engage policy makers.

Technology to facilitate investigations.

## Strategies

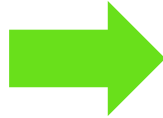
Conduct case work based on partnerships and data analysis.
