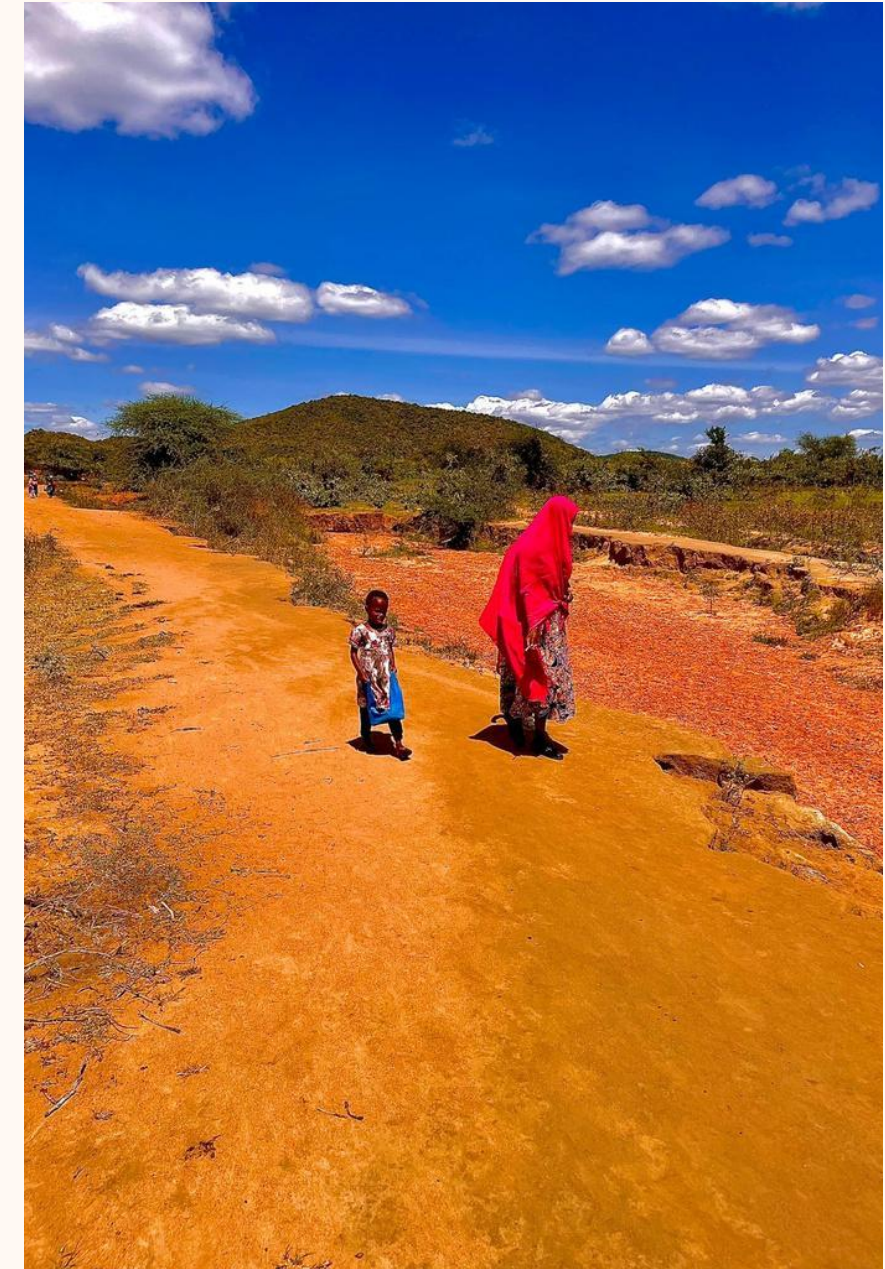


The Project

In Sarame, Tanzania, students walk up to 7km to reach overcrowded schools lacking basic sanitation. Since 2021, LifeTime Projects in coordination with Jabungu Foundation has been working to equip young people from Sarame and surrounding rural communities with practical, job-ready skills through access to quality vocational education. Our curriculum is designed to bridge education and economic opportunity, offering hands-on training in IT, sustainable tourism, hospitality, and renewable-energy maintenance.

The Challenges

1

Access to Quality Education

Only 30% of children proceed to secondary education.
Students have to walk 3km to 7km to go to school.

2

Gender Inequality

Less than 50% of girls enroll in secondary school.
Many girls are forced to abandon their studies prematurely if pregnant.

3

Sanitation

63% of schools do not meet the recommended number of students per toilet and only 6.4% of schools have basic hygiene facilities.

4

Nutrition

Malnutrition has a direct negative impact on students' school attendance, learning capacity, and long-term academic success.

Our Solution



Building a vocational high school close to students' homes with **classrooms capped at 35 students** for better quality education. **Delivering hands-on vocational training** in IT, sustainable tourism, renewable energy, and hospitality.

Integrating a gender-sensitive approach, preventing early dropout.

Installing WASH facilities, promoting dignity and health. **Setting up rainwater-harvesting tanks** for reliable and sustainable water supply. **Powering the school with solar energy**, providing clean, consistent electricity.

Cultivating a permaculture garden to supply food to the school and provide at least one balanced meal per student per day.

SDGs in our Solution



Combating malnutrition through the permaculture garden and nutritious school meals.



Equitable access to practical, inclusive, and effective learning. Smaller classes for better engagement.



Support for girls' education and gender-responsive infrastructure. Access to menstrual hygiene products.

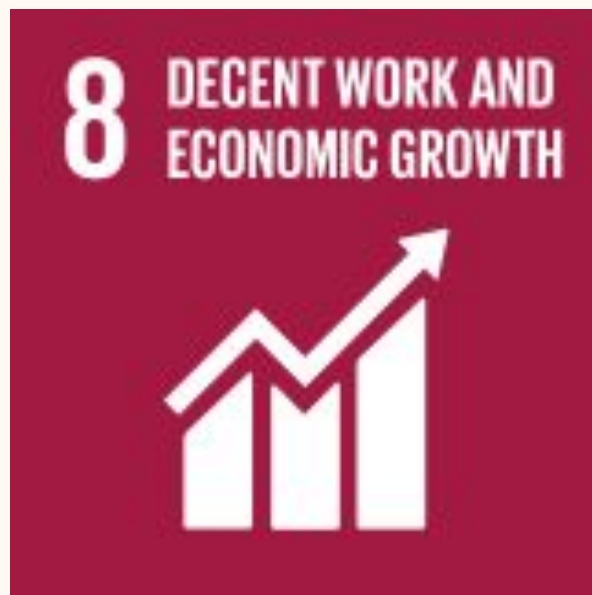


Access to safe water, sanitation, and hygiene for all students and for the community of Magugu.

Our Impact

140 adolescents aged 14 to 18 in Sarame and its environs will gain regular access to quality education and hands-on vocational training.

Their families will become deeply involved through workshops and community-wide awareness activities.

A team of 16 local professionals, (12 teachers and 4 support staff) will be recruited, providing stable employment.

Ultimately, more than 5 230 residents of Sarame will experience the ripple effects of this investment, new jobs, improved health from better WASH facilities, and an energized local economy driven by the graduates.



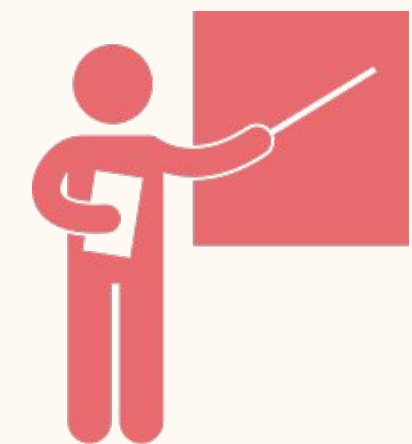

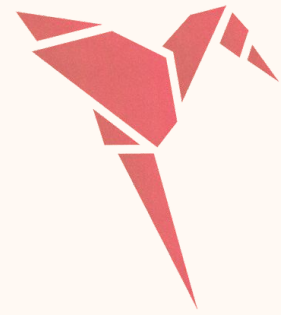
