- Invest in impactful and scalable social enterprises whose work strengthens and aligns with YCAB's vision




Access to Education Significantly Improves Welfare and Have Long Lasting Impact




Higher education results in higher income in first 5 years in the career

Indonesian students who completed their tertiary education typically begins their career with a ~70% higher income.
