

Primary Education Project Diocese of Hyderabad Church of Pakistan Flood Updates August 2022



Situation Overview

The humanitarian situation in Pakistan has deteriorated further over the past two weeks as heavy rains continue to cause flooding, and landslides resulting in displacement and damage across the country. According to the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) report till 26 August 2022,

- 116 districts affected, including 66 districts officially declared 'calamity hit'.
- At least 1043 people killed and 1,343 people injured since 14 June.
- Rainfall nationwide is 2.87 times higher than the national 30-year average, with some provinces
- The humanitarian situation is expected to worsen as communities and infrastructure are increasingly unable to cope with ongoing heavy rainfall.
