
Made Clean

The Made Clean program continues to bring hope to Syrian refugees through a mobile laundry service and an accompanying children's program. Until this year, our cycle in each camp only lasted for three months; however, in 2022, we extended the program so that we could spend a year in each camp. This extra time allowed us to build deeper relationships with families and enrich the children's program with new educational, psychosocial, and awareness activities. This allowed the children to learn new things from an educational perspective. Teaching kids about personal hygiene is crucial to help them develop good habits that will benefit them throughout their lives.
