ABOUT US

O Centro de Acolhida Betânia

The Betânia Reception Centre is the structure that hosts all ASV projects and activities. It was born in 1990 to welcome the service of coexistence and strengthening of the bonds for children and adolescents and after almost 35 years of history there are more than 6000 people who benefited from the services of this good structure!



The context in which we operate

Belo Horizonte (BH) is the capital of the state of Minas Gerais and the third largest city in Brazil by extension.

Out of a population of more than 6 million inhabitants, 50% belong to the age group from 0 to 11 years old and 40% live in a state of extreme poverty and benefit from public aid (Relatorio cadastro unico 11 2020).

In the West area of BH, of the 308,589 residents with more than 68,000 (IBGE 2010), equal to 24%, live with income ranging from half a minimum wage, in degraded neighborhoods or favelas. 40% of the population lives below the poverty line (odsBH report), dedicating themselves to occasional, informal and low-paid jobs.

Against an average per capita income of BH residents of R\$ 1,497.29/month (€ 320), 60% poorer have income of R\$ 324 (€ 70) (João Pinheiro Foundation, 2010), with negative inevitable repercussions to the detriment of minors, young people and the elderly. Betânia, district in which some project activities, is located in the west of BH.

It is inhabited by 44,199 people (IBGE - Census 2010), of which 25% are 0 to 15 years old and 10% are over 60 years old. The western region of Betania, area affected by the project, is the second region of the city with the highest index of minors and young people from 0 to 21 years (City Hall BH 2013) who, due to the multidimensional poverty that affects the area, they suffer different forms of poverty, in the first place educational, materials, and are exposed to various forms of fragility and discrimination. the children beneficiaries of the project also come from a favela called Vila Nova Paraíso, where 60% of the inhabitants are women of color and where 50% of the families depend on the woman of the house with average income equal to a minimum wage (Inequality Map of BH, 2021).

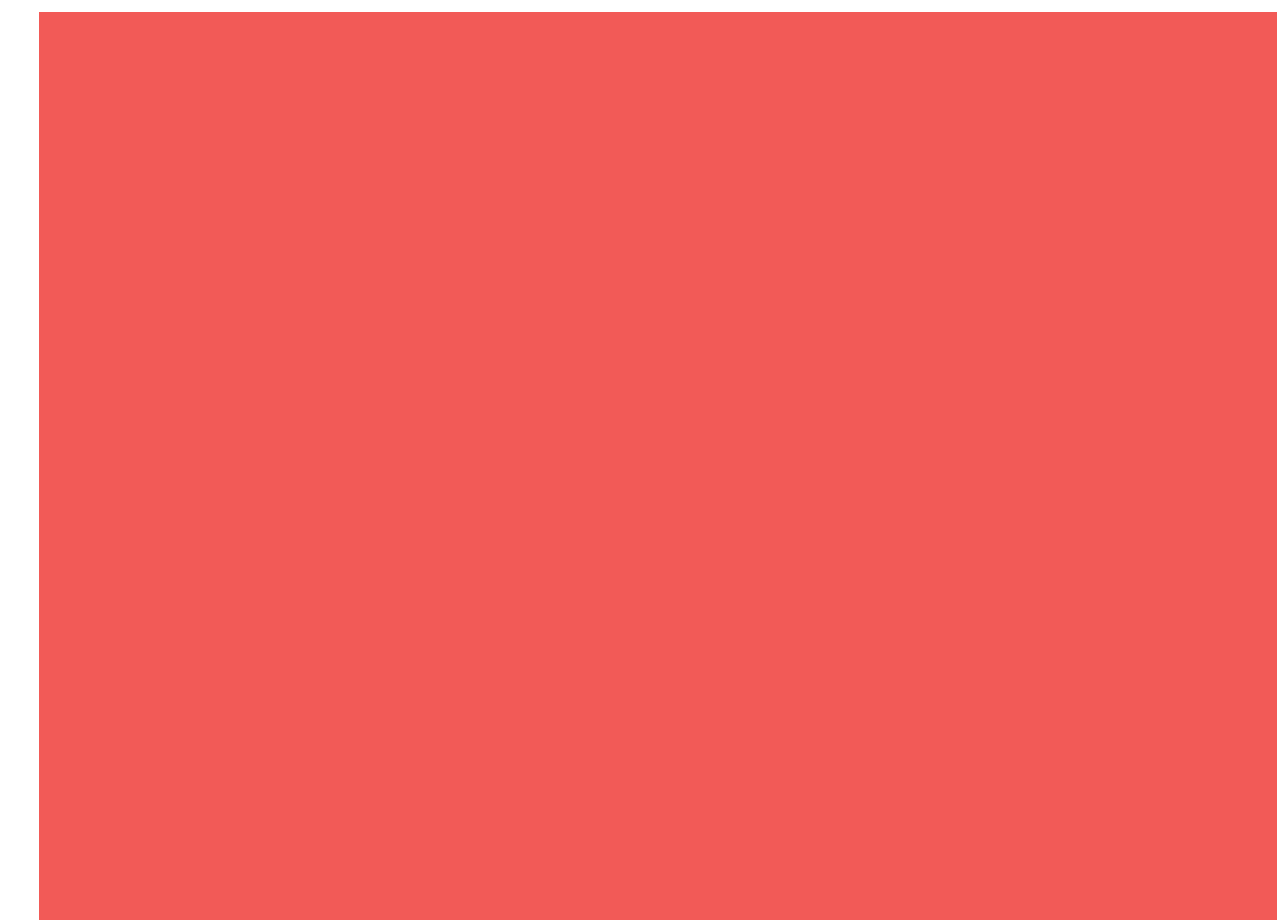
