




- Over 2m Ukrainian schoolchildren are in the traditional or mixed education format
- Almost 2m students study online
- Around 14k air-raids in 2022 interrupted the educational process
- The educational process is only possible in 12,900 schools (84%)
- 74% of schools have shelters
- More than 2,800 educational institutions were destroyed.

#### Some of our ongoing projects:

- Development of psychological resilience for <u>educators</u> and <u>schoolchildren</u>
- <u>Catch-up classes</u> for students in grades 5-11 who need additional courses to master the material of the main subjects and make up for what they missed due to the war
- Stay with Ukraine. The project is for Ukrainian children who were forced to flee abroad due to the russian full-scale invasion. It is designed to help maintain a connection with the homeland



























































# "Skrynia v Ukryttia"

### "Chest for Shelter"



#### The project is developed by

- NGO "Smart Osvita" team
- Psychologist expert Svitlana Royz
- Children's Reading Laboratory "BaraBuka" of the National Center "Minor Academy of Sciences of Ukraine"
- Visual activities for children are designed by illustrator Lidia Golosko



We created a resource chest to ensure a more comfortable stay in bomb shelters for both children and teachers.

- 3 kind of chest sets adopted for age of elementary school, middle school, and senior school
- Designed for simultaneous usage
- Includes elements to help children deal with stress and anxiety anti-stress toys, puzzles, origami schemes, lighting devices, warming blankets, board games, a selection of books, coloring pages on patriotic themes
- 1 chest for 100 children

- 370 schools from all over Ukraine <u>applied</u> to receive our "Chests for Shelter"
- As first part of the project, the NGO "Smart Osvita" in the partnership and financial support with the Eastern Europe Foundation, ChildFund and Terre des Hommes have reached first 15 schools
- First 15 boxes were sent to schools in Poltava, Rivne, Chernihiv, Odesa, Kropyvnytskyi, Kyiv, Cherkasy, Zhytomyr



Based on the evaluation of the first phase of the project, we received positive feedback from the teachers and increased number of request appeared hear after.
