

## La Enseñanza's Profile

*La Enseñanza* was built in 1898, it belonged to the Flores Morales family. On August 15th, 1915, the family opened "La Enseñanza" School in their home. The students came mainly from *Chiapas, Oaxaca, Tabasco, Veracruz, Guatemala* and *El Salvador*.

As a school it housed seven educational spaces at the same time: the specialized school for girls and young ladies, the boarding school for young ladies, the elementary school for girls, the boarding school for boys, the free night school for workers and workers' children, *La Enseñanza*: Secondary School and Normal School. It officially closed its doors in 1986.

In 2006 it became part of the Cultural Association Na Bolom A.C., a non-profit association, functioning since 2013 as a space for culture and the arts for the city of San Cristóbal de Las Casas.

La Enseñanza Casa de La Ciudad is currently listed as a historical monument located at *Belisario Domínguez #13* in San Cristóbal de las Casas, Chiapas, is a cultural space where artistic, cultural and academic activities such as temporary exhibitions, workshops, concerts, plays, lectures, among others. This space is independent and self-sustainable and is maintained thanks to donations from visitors and the activities that can be carried out here, these donations allow us to continue with arrangements and maintenance of the rooms to provide more adequate spaces for the activities of the cultural and artistic agenda. As a cultural center it has participated as organizer and/or venue in festivals such as the Cervantino Baroque, photography, book fairs, cinema, among others.
