

ZA Cheetah Conservation is a registered section 18A approved NPC, PBO No. 930064801, endangered species breeding centre in Bela-Bela, South Africa.

We are home to a number of endangered and threatened species including cheetahs, leopards, male lions, servals, caracals, African wildcats, wolves, bat-eared foxes, meerkats and a Siberian tiger. Our project takes in rescued animals from the local area, so we also have various animals from time to time including a goat and antelope.

ZA Cheetah Conservation began in Bloemfontein in 2006. In the following 14 years we continued to grow until we needed to expand to a bigger land. Therefore, we moved to Bela-Bela in 2020 and have now set up our permanent base with space for expansion into the future.

At ZA Cheetah Conservation our focus is on cheetah breeding. From a recent study in 2016, the global population of the cheetah is estimated at 7,100 individuals confined to 9% of their historic range. Many of the cheetahs born with us have gone on to be part of other ethical endangered species centres.

Through the generosity of the general public, our sponsors, and income from tours, we have now successfully begun to release cheetahs back into protected reserves.
