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We have provided our Fellows with:

- Over 200 hours of leadership training
- Over 400 hours of mentorship
- Upwards of \$16,000 in micro-grants

In total, our Fellows have impacted over 72,000 people!

In 2022, we hosted our first ever Women in Education Conference, planned and executed by our very own Cohort 1 Fellows!

We hosted over 100 experts in the field of education as speakers and panelists, welcoming guests in-person in Ghana and hosting international attendees over Zoom.

We Began at the Beginning

We knew that educated girls and empowered women hold the keys to global wellbeing and we wanted to put this knowledge into action. We also knew that such women often lacked crucial tools and resources to make change. In response, we designed and tested a set of tools: leadership training, mentorship, peer partnerships, small grants and professional networking



Our Focus Group in Ghana in 2019!

In early 2020, we began implementation in Ghana, West Africa. We selected 10 applicants to become our first cohort of Fellows. Under the leadership of Ghana Country Advisor Tawiah Agyarko-Kwarteng our Fellows participated in two years of leadership, fellowship and education.



Cohort 1

Our first Cohort blew us away with their deep dedication, brilliance, enthusiasm, and passion for women's leadership. They connected instantly as a group and helped us co-design two pillars of the program: local responses to International Women's Day every March 8th and a bi-annual National Women's Education Workshop.

Cohort 2

We are one year into our Fellowships with Cohort 2, and it has been a joy to watch our program grow. For this Cohort, we have focused on expanding access to professional development opportunities, such as international Fellowships, refining their business and programmatic skills and accessing tailor made mentorships.



How We Work

We identify young women with a track record of leadership and a passion for social change. They often lack key resources such as confidence, mentorship, and funding. Through our 2-year Fellowship, we help these rockstars grow as changemakers by providing them with leadership training, mentorship, micro-grants, peer partnerships, and an alumnae network.
