

### **Coverage of medical** expenses for children

Children under our care live surrounded by the sounds of air alerts and feel helpless in the face of war that has already taken their loved ones from them. 53% are internally displaced persons. They have left their belongings, many no longer have a home, and all have faced a loss of a parent. These children and their guardians often find themselves in challenging financial circumstances and basic medical expenses become a burden they cannot afford.

**One year of insurance for one** child from 0 to 18 years old -135 USD (5000 UAH)



### **Need for Medical Insurance:**

The war has increased the need for health care while reducing the system's ability to provide services. The destruction of infrastructure, the displacement of millions of people, and the large numbers of injured in front line fighting and shelling across the country have overwhelmed the Ukrainian healthcare system.

Our goal is to ensure children have access to essential medical services. One of the tools is a medical insurance that combines state and private medical infrastructure. This covers expenses for emergency and inpatient care as well as prescribed medicines.

Our team made a request for a commercial proposal and chose a provider for this program. The insurance company "Providna" gives us a special discount, has high quality standards and ensures that all basic healthcare needs of children are met.







## **Other medical expenses**

There are special needs that insurance does not cover. So within the framework of this support program the fund will, if necessary, compensate the costs in the following cases:

 Treatment of diseases arising as a result of severe psychological trauma Helping children injured as a result of russian aggression Medical support for children with disabilities or serious illnesses (Parkinson's, cerebral palsy, etc.) Annual health check-ups

Our comprehensive program aims to meet the diverse medical needs of all children in our care, focusing on early detection, prevention, and overall improvement of their physical and psychological well-being.
