## Above All Else

Everyone has the right to live with dignity, free from being deprived of the necessities of life. At H2H, we reach out to those precious families living in the slums of Pattaya, trying to raise their children in alcohol and drug environments, many physically, mentally, emotionally and sexually abused, in a state of quiet desperation. Through the love of Jesus Christ, H2H staff and volunteers embrace them and offer hope in a nurturing, all encompassing environment. We clothe, feed, educate, train, play and support everyone who reaches out to us for help. Some of our children have no documentation and thus no status or financial support. We help parents navigate the government processes to obtain birth certificates, government ID registration numbers which gives them access to education, health care and job opportunities.

### **Pre-School**

Children aged 3 to 6 years, mainly from slum areas, attend FREE bilingual preschool Monday to Friday. Socialization, music, activities, games, food, clothing, medical care and love are the order of every day.

Food for 25 children 1 Week – 4000B\$ 1 Month -16, 000\$1 Year – 192, 000\$ Books/Stationary 1 Month -1000\$



#### **Kids Club**

Saturdays are busy with games, crafts, songs, and activities as children learn through play. There is also a one hour Computer class and hour long English lesson. Plus a healthy meal is served.



### Hospit al

Volunteers visit the children's ward at Banglamung hospital weekly. Where appropriate we provide diapers and specialized milk and all children will receive a toy, game or colouring book and crayons.

Pampers – 600\$ per pack Specialized milk for malnourished babies – 700\$ per 375g tin Average expenditure per month - 12000 \$



### Scholarship

100 children are given the opportunity to go to school through generous donations that help their parents pay for school uniforms, transportation, supplies, books, breakfast and a daily snack.



#### Housing and Life Skills Project

FREE housing provides a safe refuge for families away from drug, alcohol and abusive environments, prevalent in the slums. Children are raised in family units rather than in orphanages, foster care, or being sold or trafficked. H2H Foundation works closely with the police and social welfare officers to provide housing and life/job training for the residents so that they can live independent lives. Opportunities for skills training include sewing, agricultural projects, cooking and furniture making.



#### **Prison Ministry**

Twice a week staff and volunteers visit Soi 9 and Banglamung prisons. The inmates are given food, water, clothing and medical treatment as needed. Children in the prison are given milk, pampers, and toys.

We provide assistance to foreign inmates needing to contact family and embassies.

Per visit – average 85 people 10008 Per week -average 255 people 20008. Per month – average 1,020 people 80008
