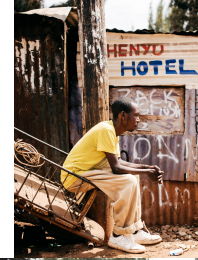
Kibagare Slum, Nairobi

St Martins located in heart of Kibagare settlement. 50K residents, 2k Houses.

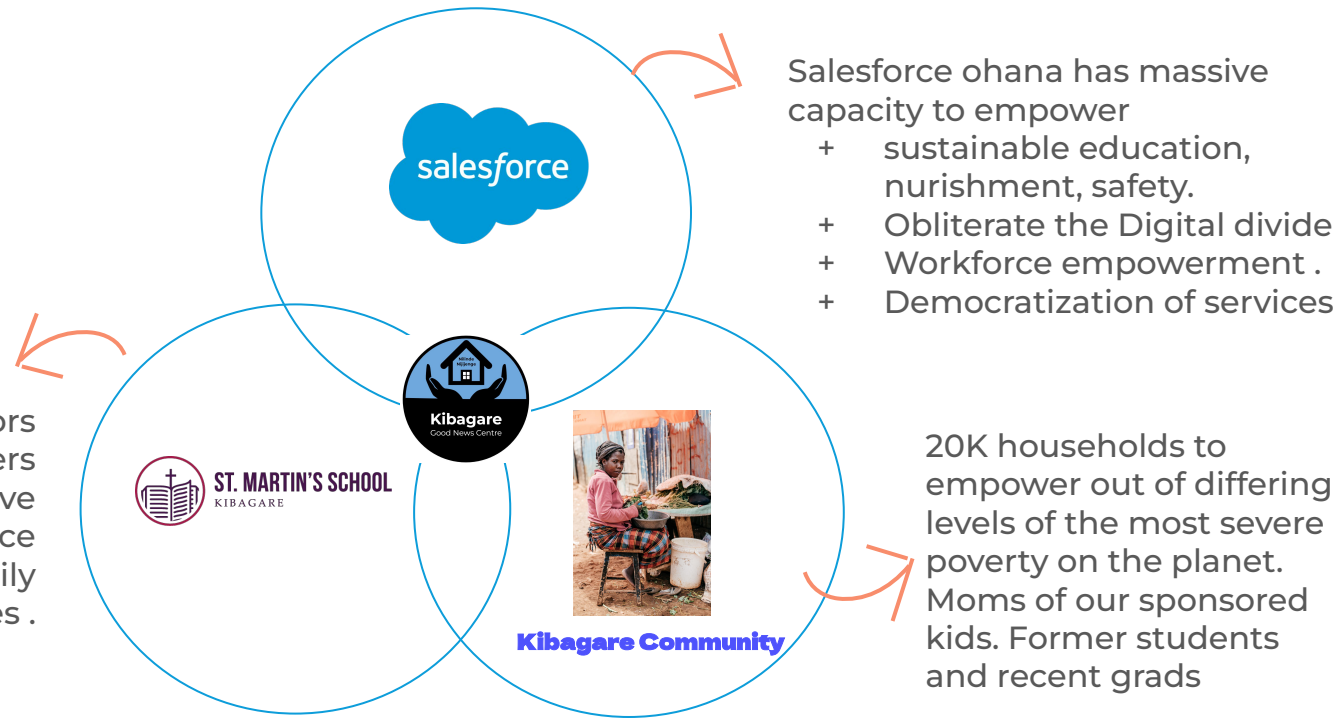
St Martins school family homes now collaborating in nearly 20 parents groups (mostly moms)
