Our mission is to preserve and promote the rich cultural heritage of Somalia. The town of Taleh, located in the eastern Sool region, is home to historic tombs and structures dating back to the 1800s and earlier.

Somalia's numerous ancient and medieval sites, remnants of powerful trade cities and kingdoms, deserve preservation for future generations. However, Somalia has never signed the UNESCO charter, making none of its historic sites eligible for World Heritage Status.

We advocate for the Somali government to sign the UNESCO charter, aiming to list these ancient sites as World Heritage candidates. In addition to advocacy, we develop public awareness of Somali culture and heritage, ensuring that young Somalis can be proud of their cultural identity.







OUR MISSION IS TO PRESERVE AND PROMOTE THE RICH CULTURAL HERITAGE OF SOMALIA. TALEH, LOCATED IN THE EASTERN SOOL REGION, IS HOME TO HISTORIC TOMBS AND STRUCTURES DATING BACK TO THE 1800S AND EARLIER. SOMALIA'S NUMEROUS ANCIENT AND MEDIEVAL SITES, REMNANTS OF INFLUENTIAL TRADE CITIES AND KINGDOMS, DESERVE PRESERVATION FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS.

SOMALIA HAS NEVER SIGNED THE UNESCO CHARTER, MAKING NONE OF ITS HISTORIC SITES ELIGIBLE FOR WORLD HERITAGE STATUS. WE ADVOCATE FOR THE SOMALI GOVERNMENT TO SIGN THE UNESCO CHARTER, AIMING TO LIST THESE ANCIENT SITES AS WORLD HERITAGE CANDIDATES. IN ADDITION TO ADVOCACY, WE DEVELOP PUBLIC AWARENESS OF SOMALI CULTURE AND HERITAGE, ENSURING THAT YOUNG SOMALIS CAN BE PROUD OF THEIR CULTURAL IDENTITY.

FOOD RELIEF

DADAAB CAMPS



The Dadaab refugee camp in Kenya houses over 200,000 refugees, primarily from Somalia.



Providing food to the camp residents is a significant logistical challenge. The World Food Program manages food distribution, delivering monthly rations of grains, pulses, vegetable oil, and corn-soy blend.

However, these rations often fail to meet nutritional needs, leading to high malnutrition rates, especially among children. Food aid travels over 500km from Mombasa, facing delays on poor roads. Upon arrival, the aid is distributed across Dadaab's five sub-camps. Refugees line up at distribution centers to collect their rations, but insecurity sometimes disrupts deliveries.

Despite the best efforts of aid agencies, many refugees struggle to feed their families, with limited opportunities to supplement their food supply.
